NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON A REGULATION

Notice of Workshop and Hearing for the Adoption, Amendment or Repeal of Regulations Of The State of Nevada Commission on Construction Education

The State of Nevada Commission on Construction Education will hold a workshop and public hearing at the State Contractors Board's Reno Office located at 9670 Gateway Drive, Reno, Nevada 89511 and teleconferenced to the State Contractors Board's Las Vegas Office at 2510 Corporate Circle, Suite 200, Henderson, Nevada 89074 on Tuesday, January 15, 2002. The workshop will begin at 9:00 a.m. The hearing will commence upon conclusion of the workshop. The purpose of the workshop and hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the adoption, amendment or repeal of regulations that pertain to Chapter 624 of the Nevada Administrative Code.

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.060 and 233B.0603:

- 1. The need for and purpose of the proposed regulation or amendment.

 Pursuant to NRS 624.570(5) the Commission shall adopt regulations to establish the rules of procedure for meetings of the Commission.
- 2. Either the terms or the substance of the regulations to be adopted, amended or repealed or a description of the subjects and issues involved.

The proposed regulation sets forth the rules of procedure for the meetings of the Commission on Construction Education. A copy of the proposed regulation may be obtained by writing to the Commission on Construction Education c/o the State Contractors Board, 9670 Gateway Drive, Reno, Nevada 89511.

- 3. The estimated economic effect of this proposed regulation on the business which it is to regulate and on the public.

This notice and the text of the proposed regulation will be available in the State of Nevada Register of Administrative Regulations which is prepared and published monthly by the Legislative Counsel Bureau pursuant to NRS 233B.0653, and on the Internet at http://www.leg.state.nv.us. Copies of this notice and the proposed regulation will also be mailed to members of the public upon request. A reasonable fee may be charged for copies if it is deemed necessary.

Upon adoption of any regulation, the Commission, if requested to do so by an interested person, either before adoption or within 30 days thereafter, shall issue a concise statement of the

principal reasons for and against its adoption and incorporate therein its reason for overruling the consideration urged against its adoption.

RULES OF PRACTICE AND PROCEDURE BEFORE THE COMMISSION ON CONSTRUCTION EDUCATION

- Sec. 2. Definitions. As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires, the words and terms defined in NAC 624.___ to NAC 624.___ have the meanings ascribed to them in those sections.
- Sec. 3. "Commission" defined. "Commission" means the commission on construction education.
- Sec. 4. Office of the commission. The principal office of the commission is the office of that person designated as the secretary-treasurer of the commission. The office of the commission will be open during regular business hours.
- Sec. 5. Meetings. Regular meetings of the commission will be held at its principal office or such other place as the commission may specify, and at such times as the board may designate.
- Sec. 5. Scope of rules of practice. The provisions of this chapter govern practice and procedure before the commission on construction education.
 - Sec. 6. Construction, deviation from rules.
- 1. The commission will liberally construe its rules of practice to secure just, speedy and economical determination of issues before it;
- 2. The commission may permit deviation from its rules of practice where good cause appears.
- 3. The rules of practice must not be construed as conflicting with any provisions of NRS as they pertain to the commission on construction education.
 - Sec. 7. Communications with commission on construction education.
- 1. All written communications and documents should be addressed to the Secretary of the commission on construction education.
- Sec. 8. An original and two legible copies of all documents, applications or other papers must be filed with the commission.
 - Sec. 9. All proceedings before the commission will be informal.
