PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE COMMISSION ON PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS IN EDUCATION

(This regulation is part of the original Initial Draft of R116-01 posted on 9/12/01)

AUTHORITY: §§1, 3 and 8, NRS 391.019; §2, NRS 391.019 and 391.032; §§4-6, NRS 391.019, 391.021 and 391.032; §7, NRS 391.040.

- **Section 1.** Chapter 391 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as section 2 of this regulation.
- Sec. 2. To receive an endorsement as a professional superintendent of schools, an applicant must submit evidence to the department that he has completed at least 3 years of experience as a school administrator and that he:
- 1. Has completed a program of preparation for superintendent of schools approved by the board; or
- 2. Satisfies the requirements for an endorsement as a professional administrator of a school.
 - **Sec. 3.** NAC 391.160 is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 391.160 1. The department will issue the following types of administrative endorsements:
 - (a) Limited endorsement as an administrator of a school;
 - (b) Limited endorsement as an administrator of a program;
 - (c) Professional administrator of a school;
 - (d) Professional administrator of a program; and
 - (e) Supervisor of curriculum and instruction.

- 2. A person who holds an endorsement as an administrator of a school may be employed by a school district as:
 - (a) An assistant superintendent of schools;
 - (b) [A superintendent of schools;
- (c) An associate superintendent of schools;
 - [(d)] (c) A principal;
 - (d) A vice principal;
 - [(f)] (e) A supervisor;
 - (g) (f) An administrative assistant; or
 - (h) (g) A supervisor or coordinator of a:
 - (1) Program of nursing;
 - (2) Program of psychology as it is applied in a school;
 - (3) Program of speech therapy;
 - (4) Program of physical therapy;
 - (5) Program of occupational therapy; or
 - (6) Other program area.
- 3. The department will issue an endorsement as a professional superintendent of schools. A person who holds an endorsement as a professional superintendent of schools may be employed by a school district as a superintendent of schools. The provisions of this subsection do not require the board of trustees of a school district to employ a person as a superintendent of schools who holds an endorsement as a professional superintendent of schools. If a school district employs a person who holds an endorsement as a professional superintendent of schools, the person shall be deemed, for the purposes of NRS 391.110, to be a person who is

licensed as an administrator and the school district is therefore not required to employ a person who is licensed as an administrator to oversee the academic programs of the public schools within the school district.

- **4**. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, a person must hold an endorsement as an administrator of a program if he supervises or coordinates a program of:
 - (a) Nursing;
 - (b) Psychology as it is applied in a school;
 - (c) Speech therapy;
 - (d) Physical therapy; or
 - (e) Occupational therapy.
- [4.] 5. A person is not required to hold an endorsement as an administrator of a school before performing services as an assistant superintendent, principal or vice principal if he holds a diploma designated as a "life diploma" by the institution that granted the diploma in the field in which he is employed.
