BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS

EXPLANATION – Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 630.130.

A REGULATION relating to physicians; requiring the holder of a license to practice medicine who wishes to change his status between active and inactive to apply to the Board of Medical Examiners for an order to change his status; providing that the Board will not grant such a change to a holder whose license is suspended for failure to pay the fee for biennial registration and submit all information required to complete the biennial registration unless the holder is reinstated within 2 years after the date his license is suspended; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. Chapter 630 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

- 1. The holder of a license to practice medicine who wishes to be:
- (a) Placed on inactive status; or
- (b) If on inactive status, authorized to resume the practice of medicine in this State,
 → must, in addition to satisfying the requirements set forth in NRS 630.255, apply to the
 Board for an order to change his status.
 - 2. The application must be on a form supplied by the Board.
- 3. If the applicant's license is suspended for failure to pay the fee for biennial registration and submit all information required to complete the biennial registration after they become due, the Board will not grant a change in status unless, not later than 2 years after the date his license is suspended, the applicant is reinstated pursuant to NRS 630.267.
