EXPLANATION - Matter in italics is new; matter in brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 501.105 and 501.181.

A REGULATION relating to wildlife; prohibiting a person from hunting any wildlife using a radio signal or other information received from any transmitting device that is attached to the wildlife; requiring a person who kills any wildlife to which a transmitting device is attached to notify the Department of Wildlife and coordinate the return of the transmitting device to the Department under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

- **Section 1.** Chapter 503 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
- 1. A person shall not hunt any wildlife using a radio signal or other information received from any transmitting device that is attached to the wildlife.
- 2. If a person, while hunting, kills any wildlife to which any transmitting device is attached, the person shall, without undue delay, notify the Department of that fact and, if required by the Department, coordinate the return of the transmitting device to the Department.
 - 3. A person shall not intentionally break, destroy or damage any transmitting device.
- 4. The provisions of this section do not apply to an employee or agent of the Department acting in his or her official capacity.
 - 5. As used in this section, "transmitting device" means any collar or other device which:

- (a) Is attached to any wildlife; and
- (b) Emits an electronic signal or uses radio telemetry or a satellite transmission to determine the location of the wildlife.
