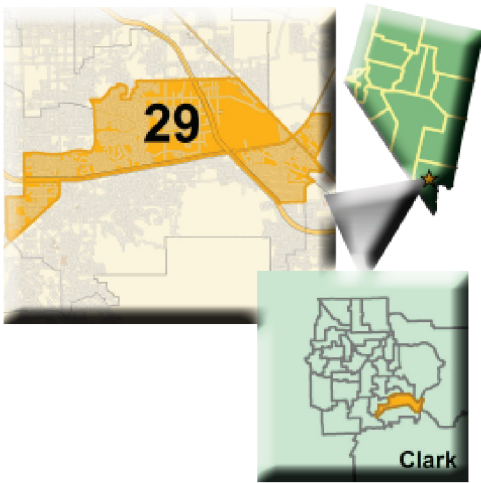

A Brief Note About the Statistics in This Document

With the exception of voter registration data on page 29, the statistical information displayed in this document was extracted from the U.S. Bureau of the Census, *2013-2017 5-Year American Community Survey (ACS)*, which became available on December 6, 2018. The ACS provides estimates of demographic, housing, social, and economic characteristics for numerous geographies every year including 5-year estimates for all geographies down to the block group level. In this document, we have used estimates that the Bureau of the Census has compiled at the legislative district and state levels for Nevada, as well as corresponding national data.

The ACS produces period estimates that describe the average socioeconomic and housing characteristics of an area over a specific period of time, not for a specific point in time. Therefore, these data may not be comparable with point-in-time estimates. Additional information about the ACS is available at the following website: <https://factfinder.census.gov/>.

Figures for active voters were obtained from Nevada's Office of the Secretary of State's website. Those figures are updated by the Secretary of State on a regular basis. The data included herein were the most currently available statistics at the time this document was prepared. 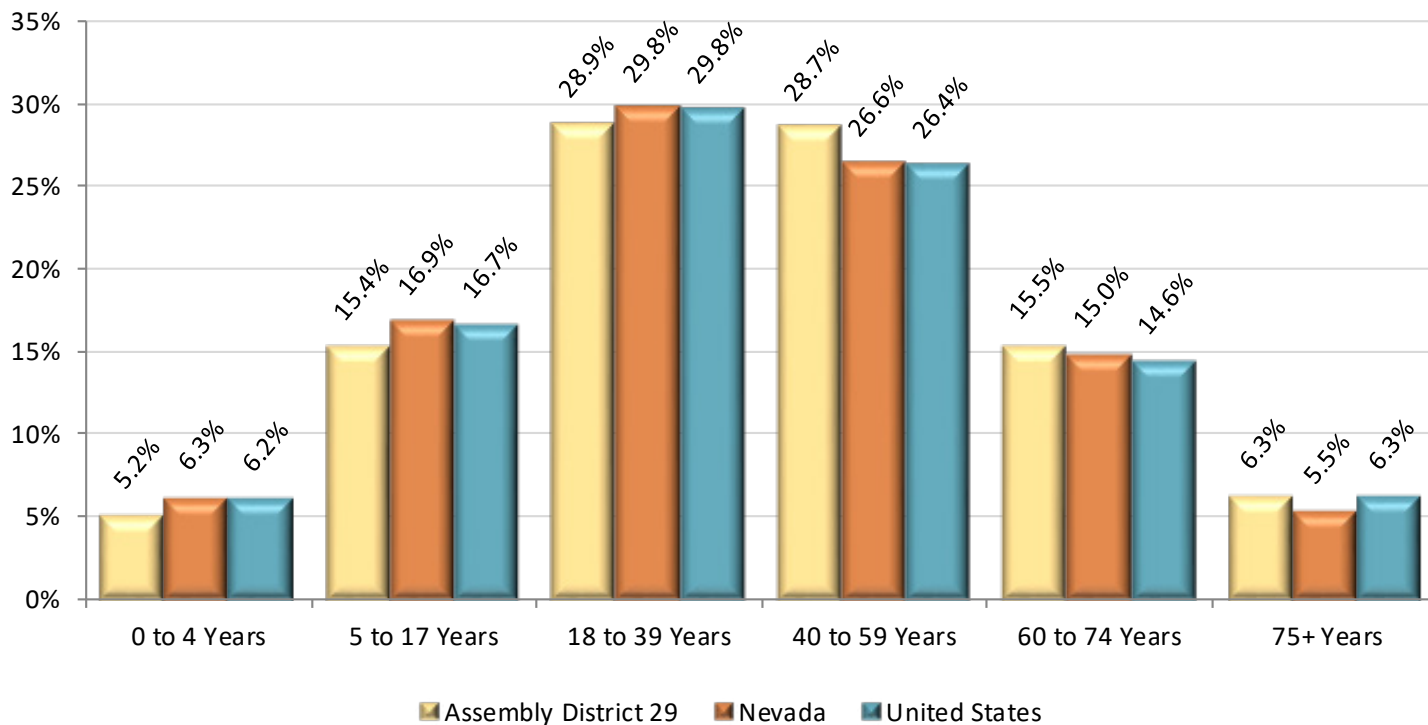

Chart 1—Population Distribution by Age

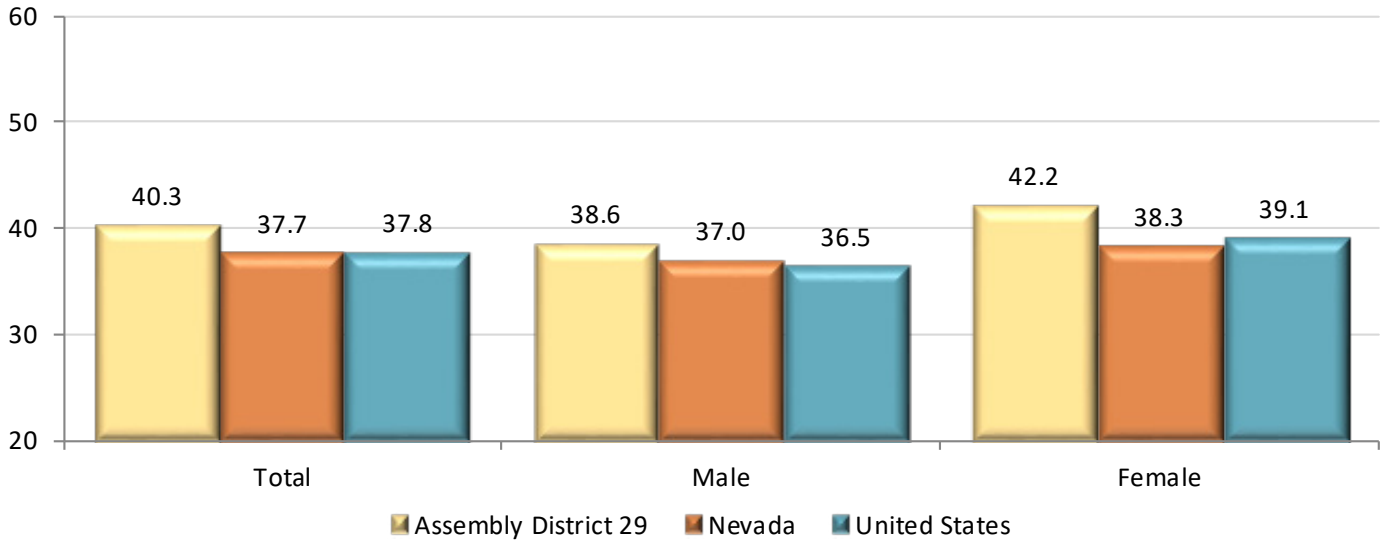

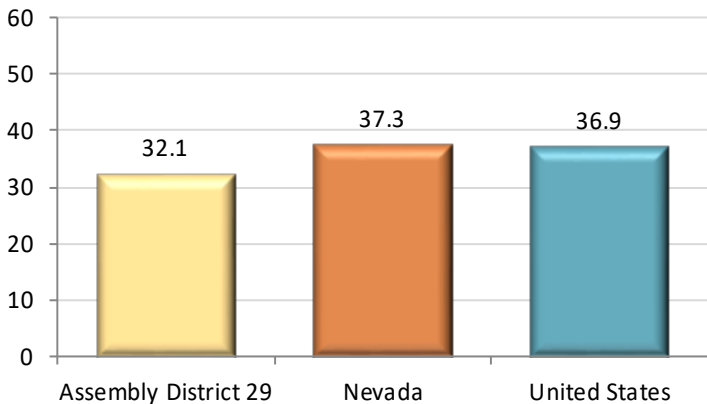

Chart 2—Median Age (in years)*



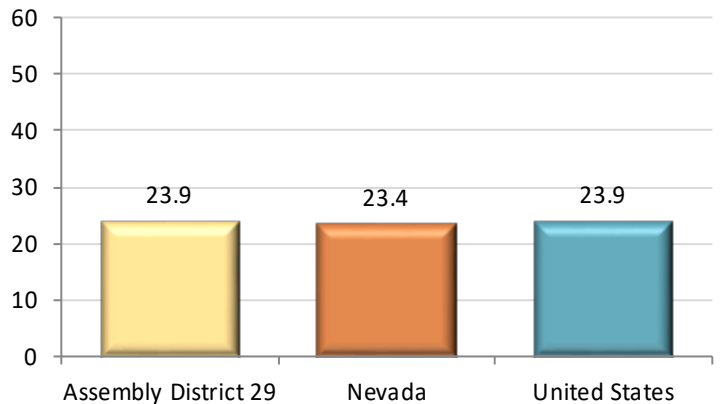

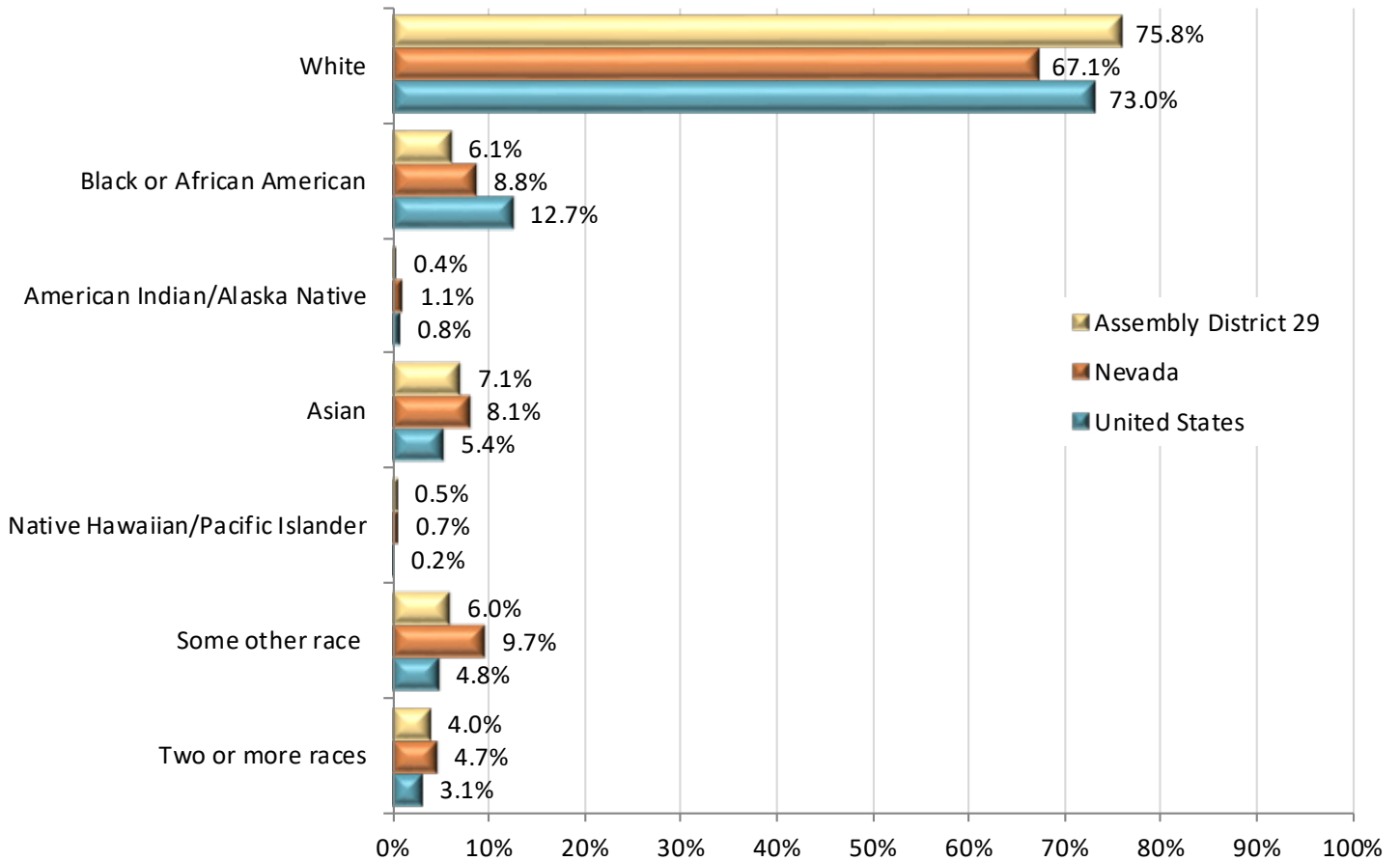

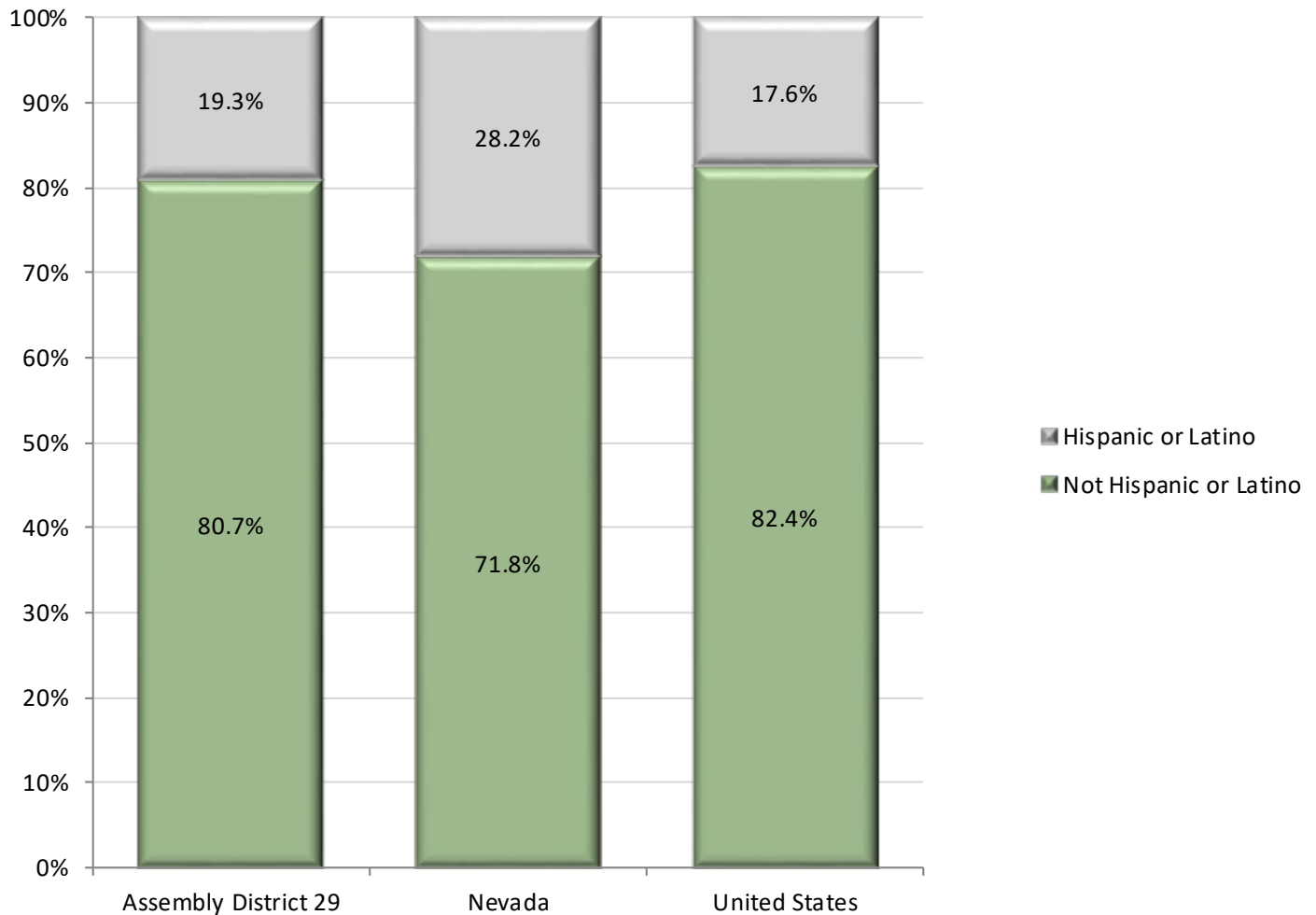

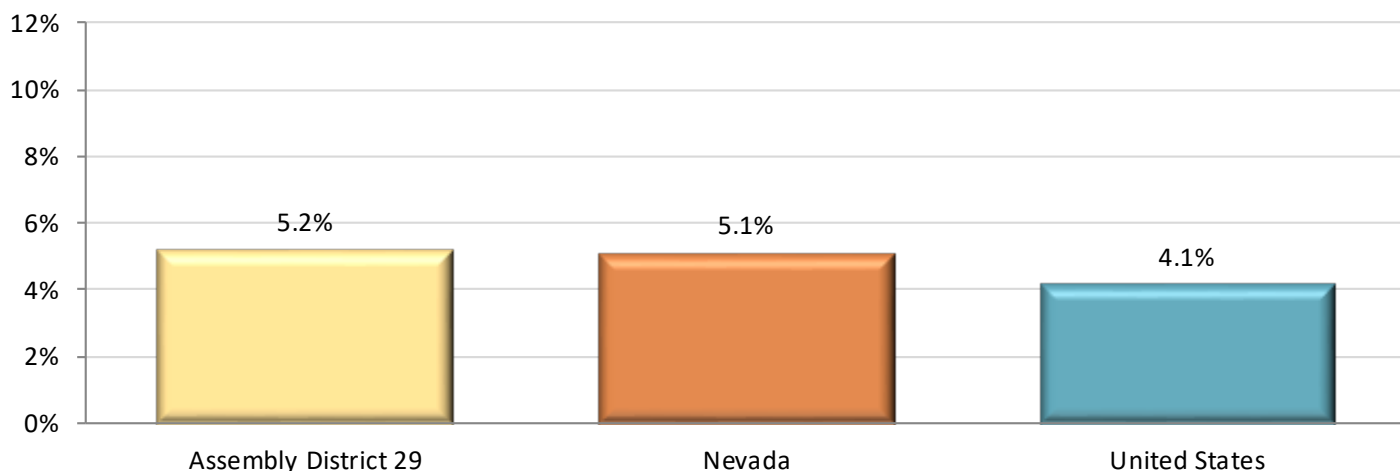

Chart 8—Labor Force Participation Rate*

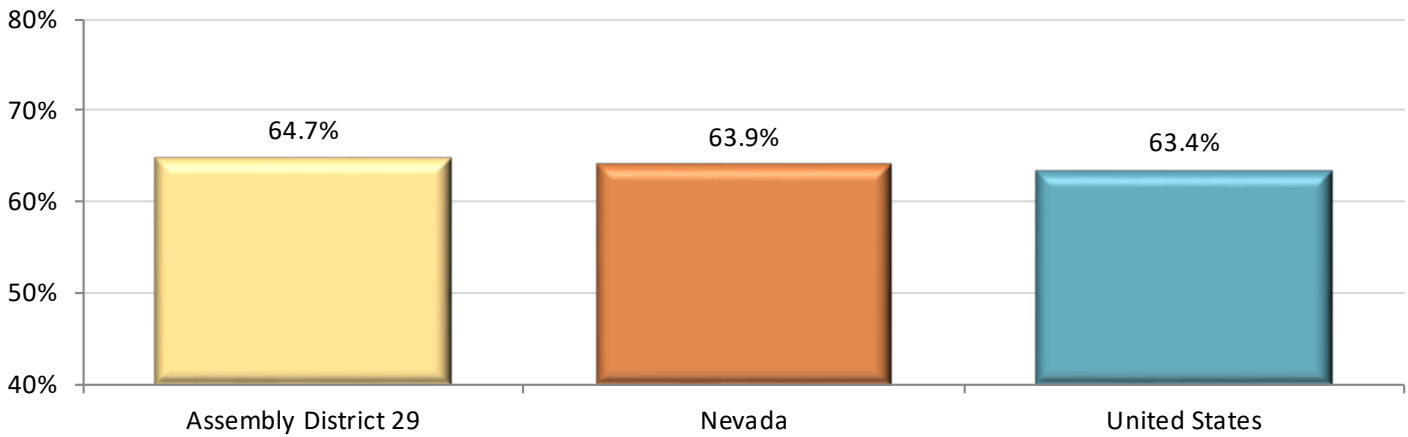
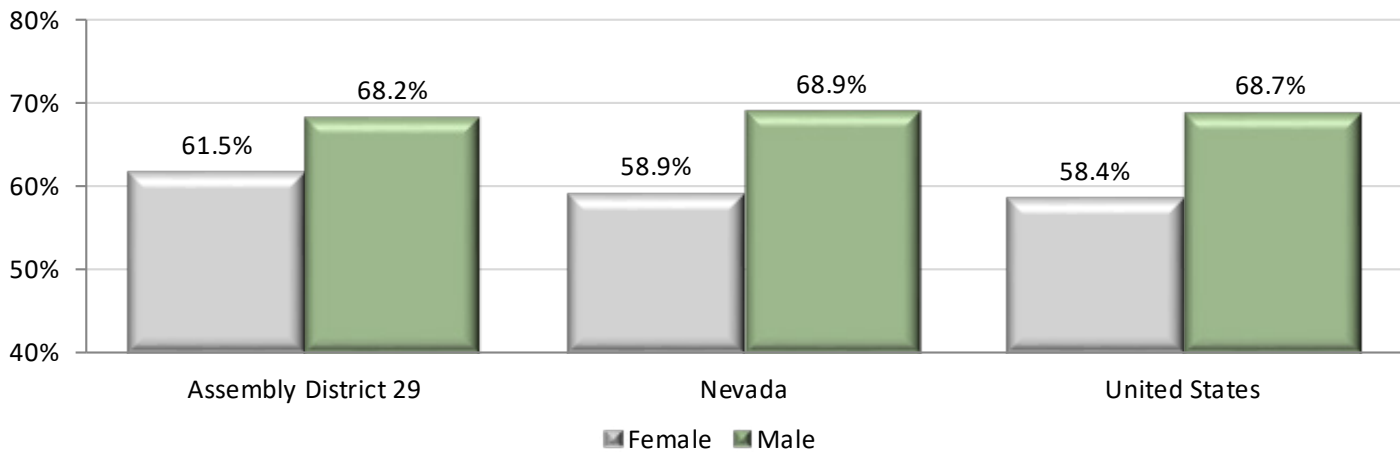


Chart 9—Labor Force Participation Rate by Gender

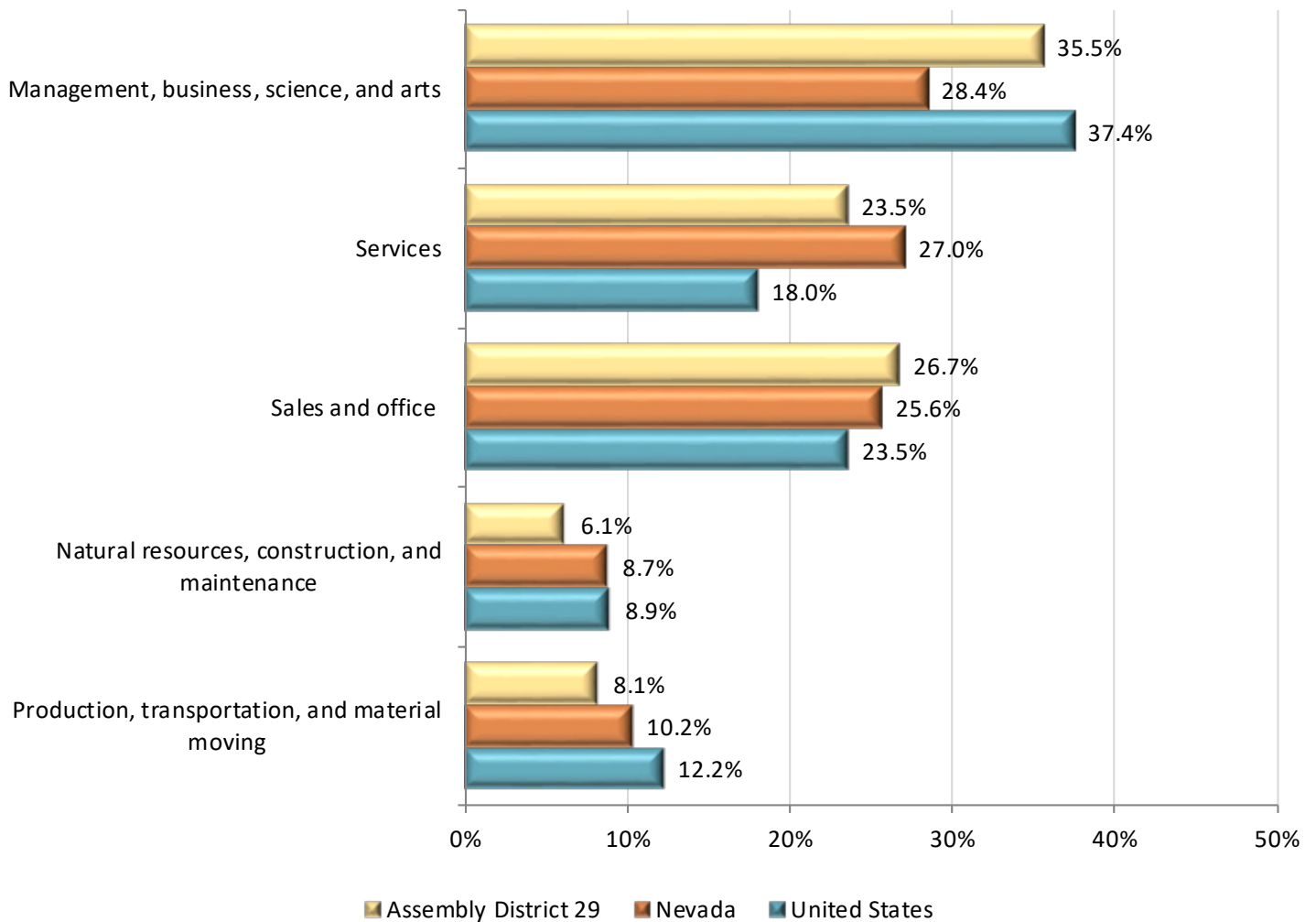

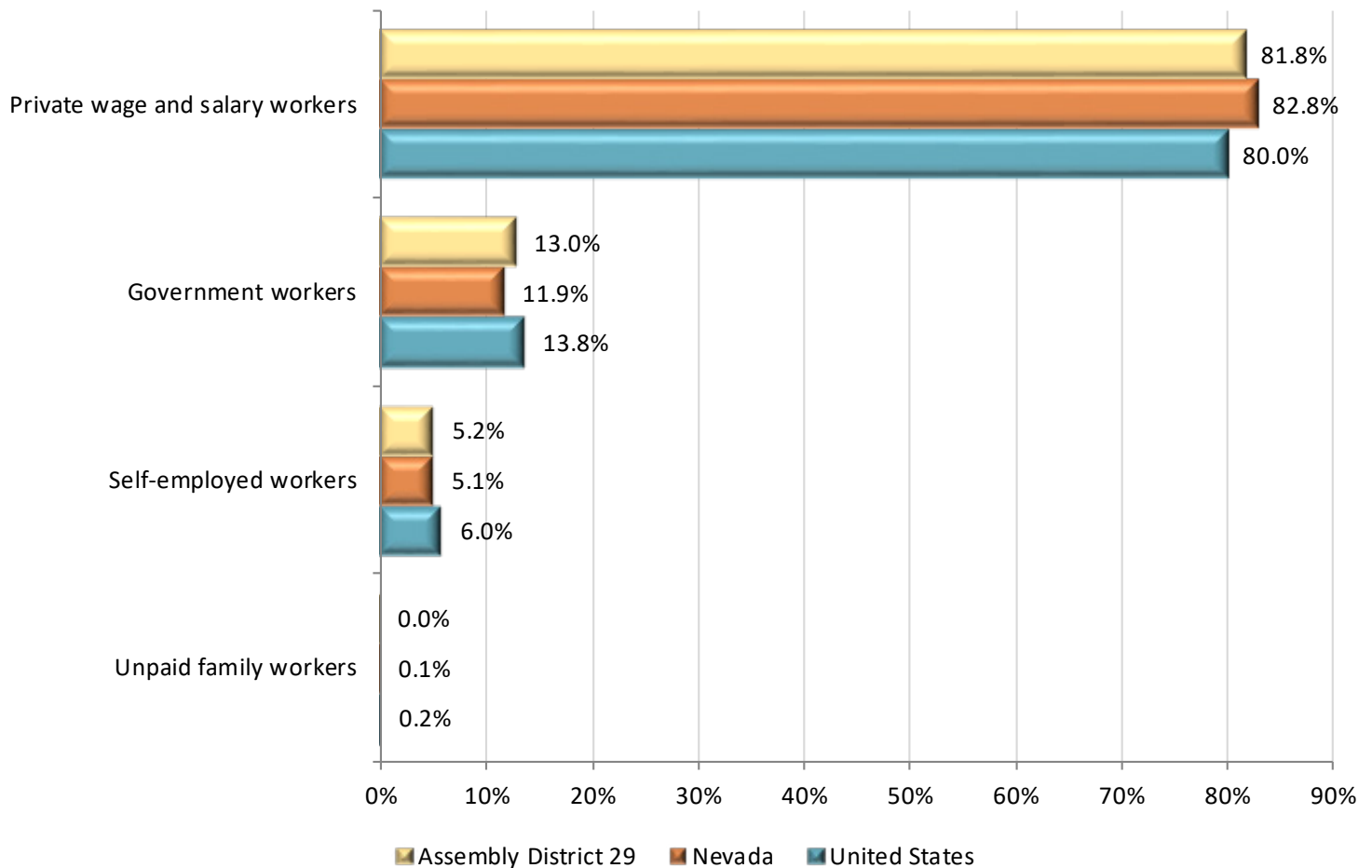

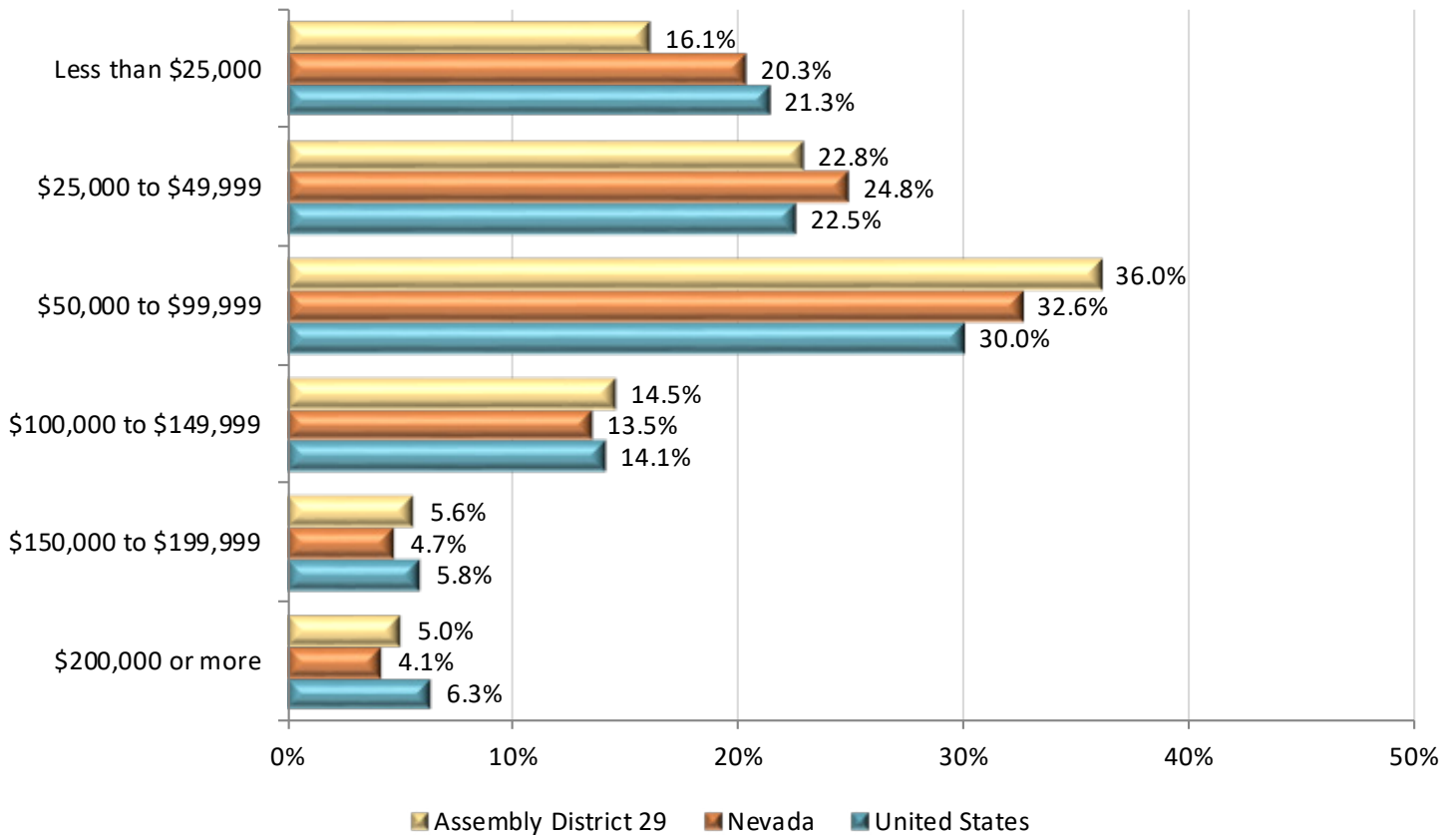

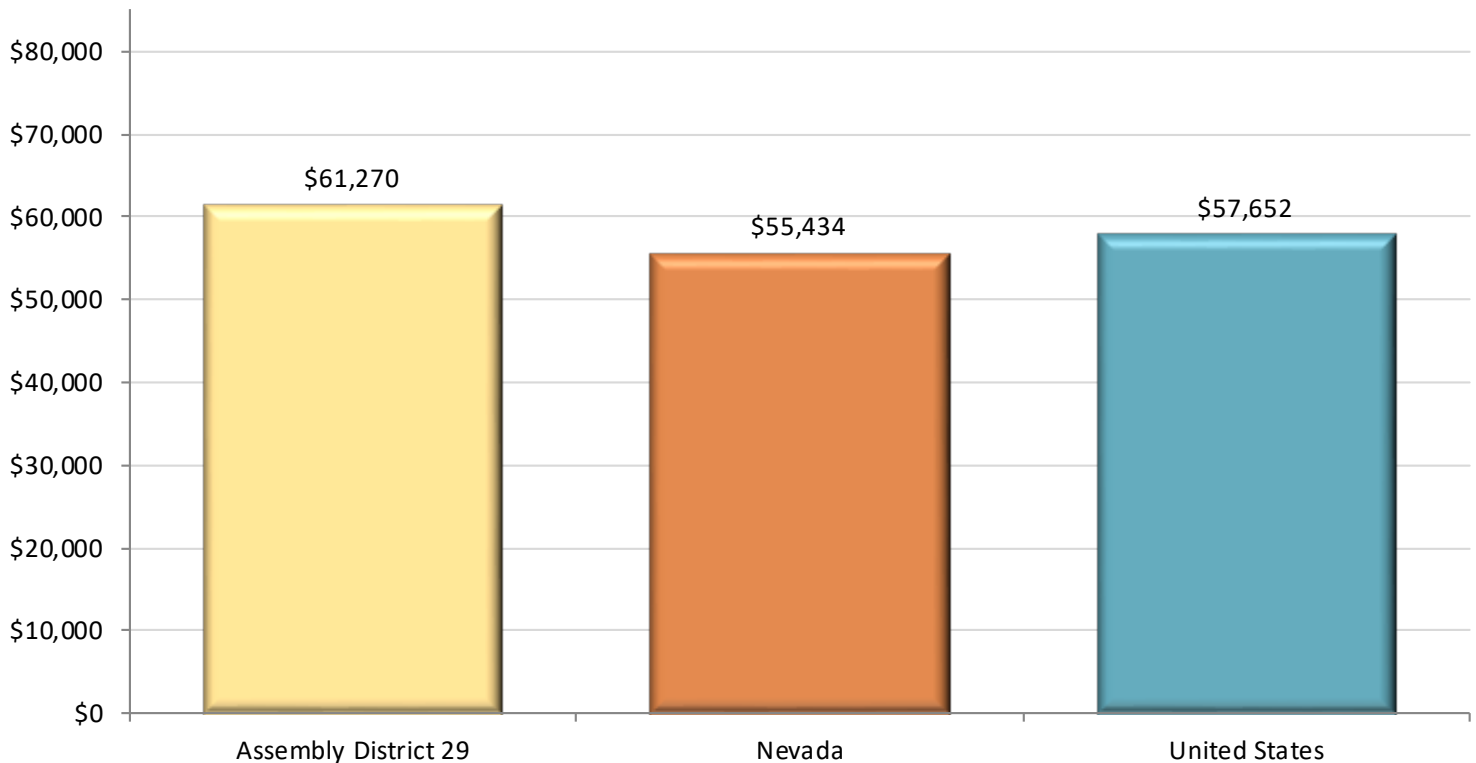

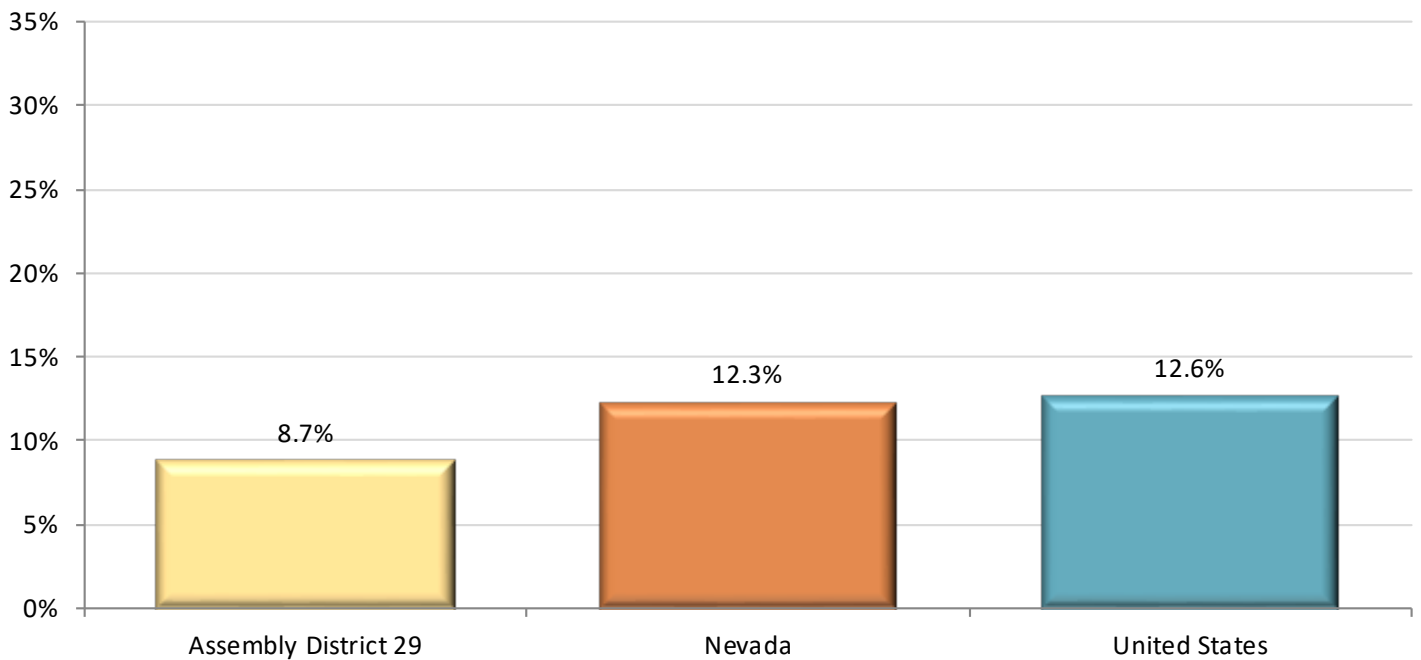

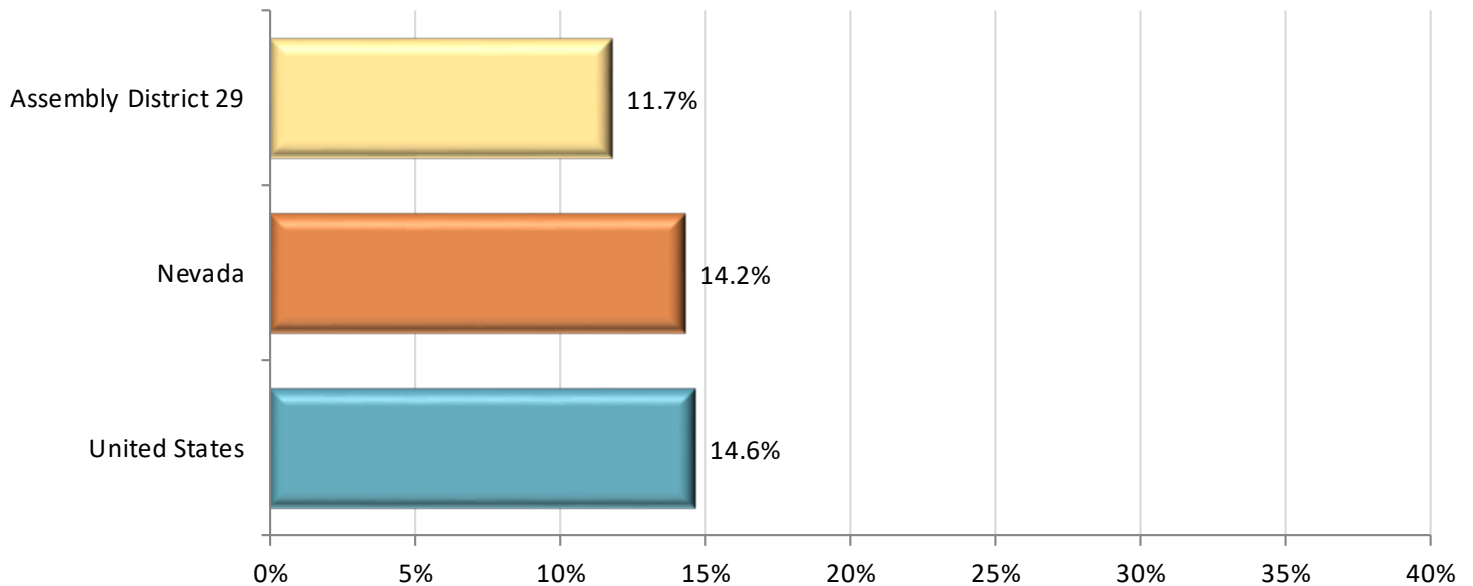

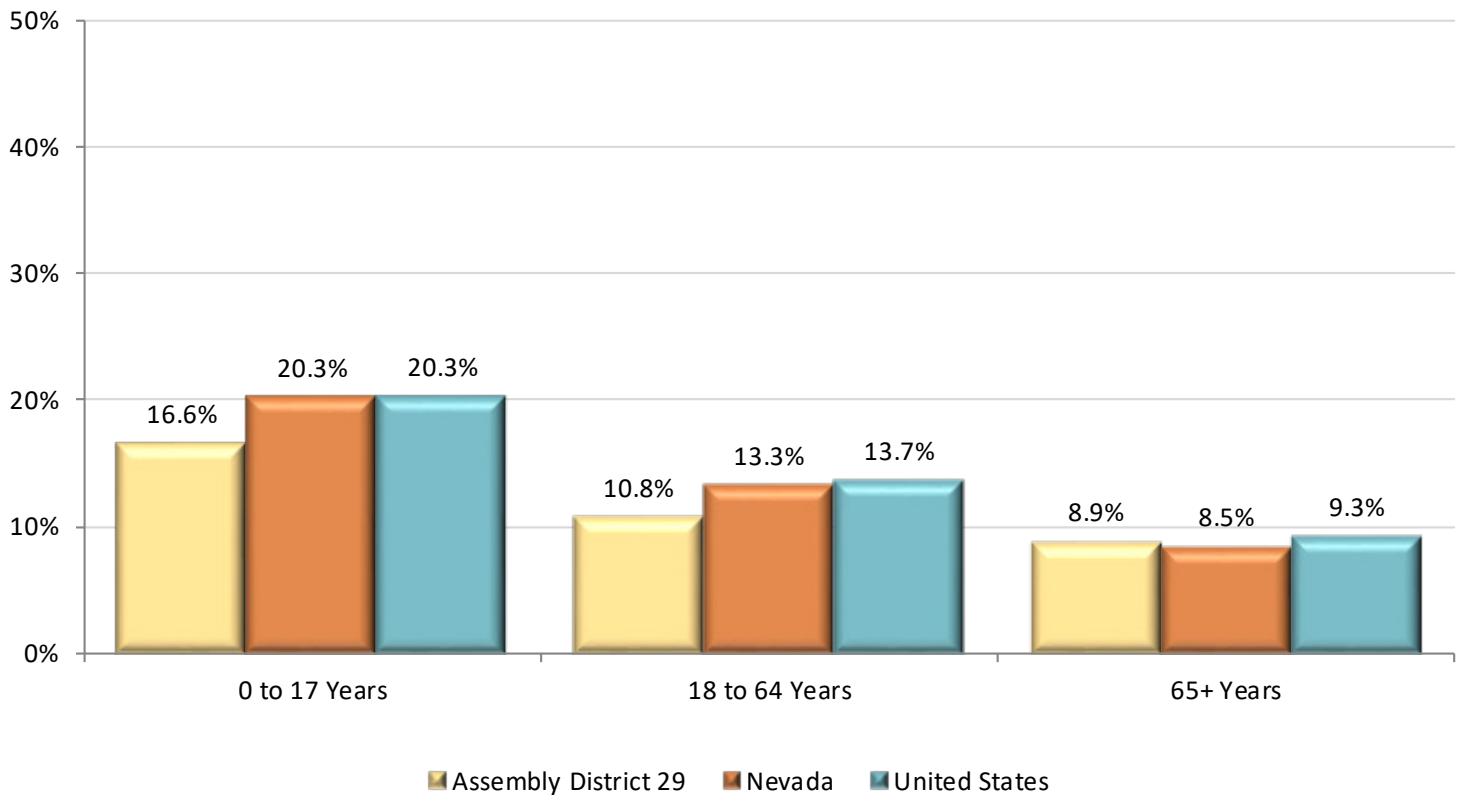

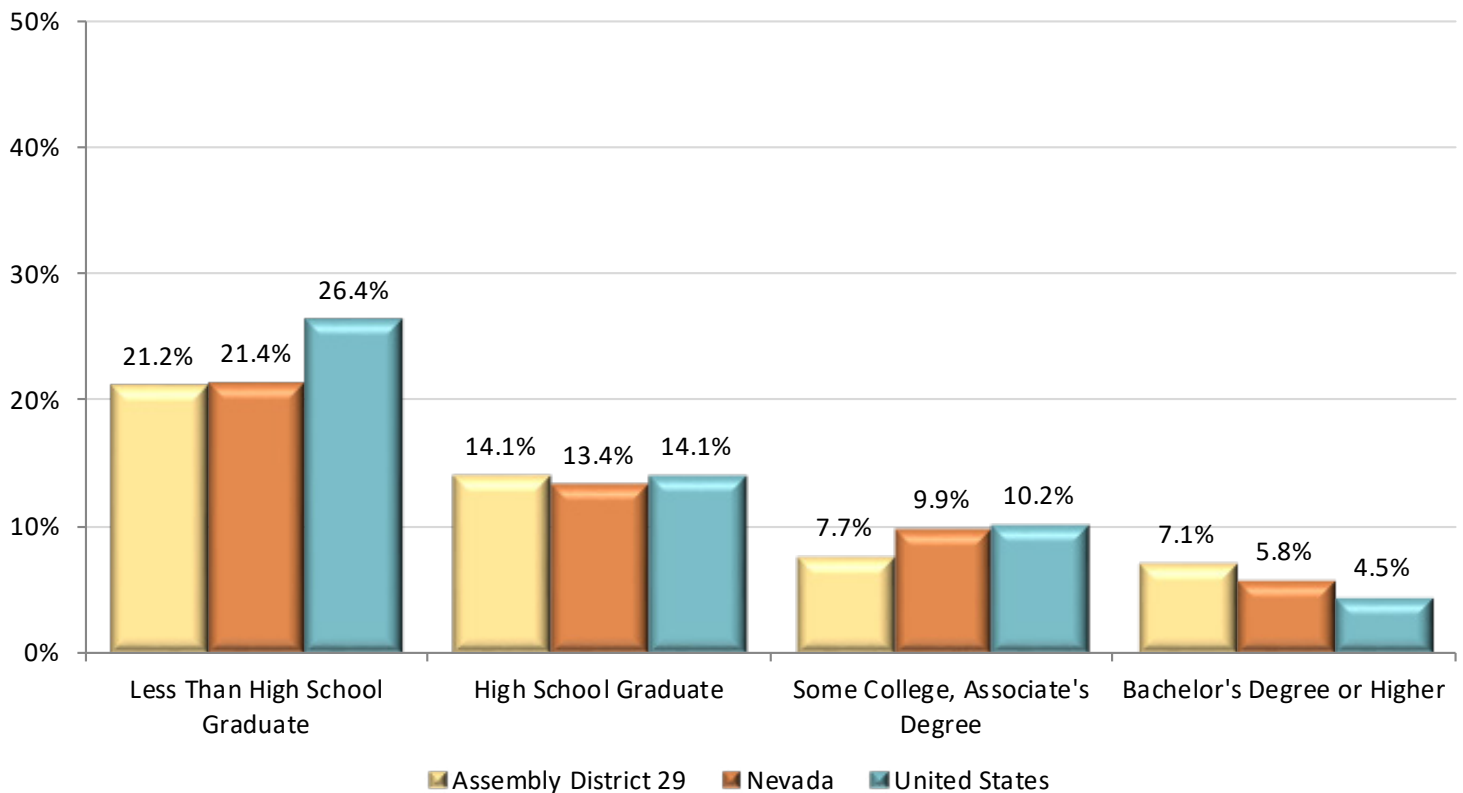

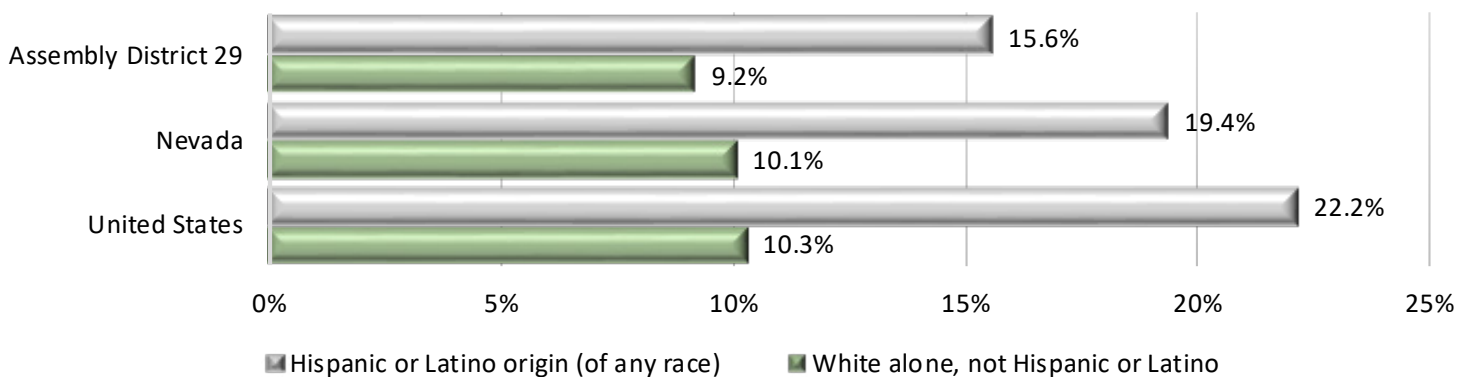

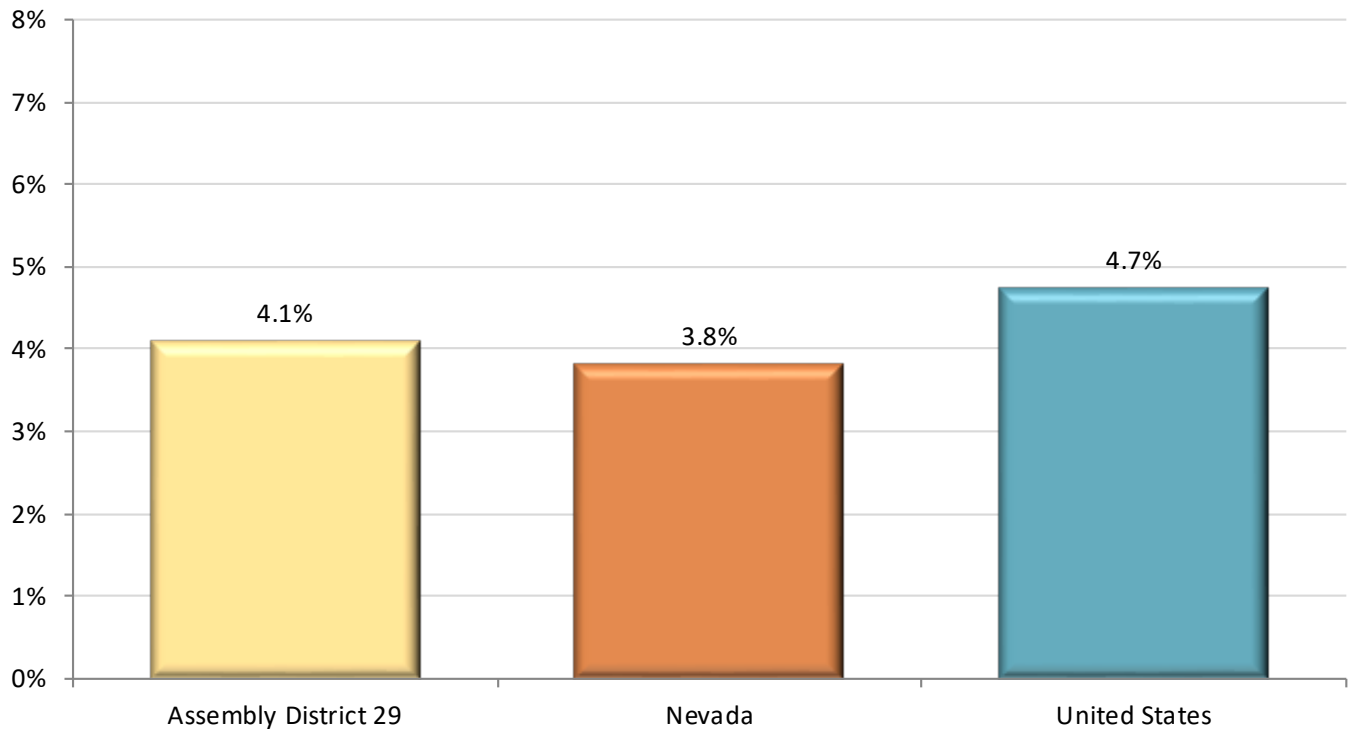

Chart 19—Percentage of Workers Who Work at Home

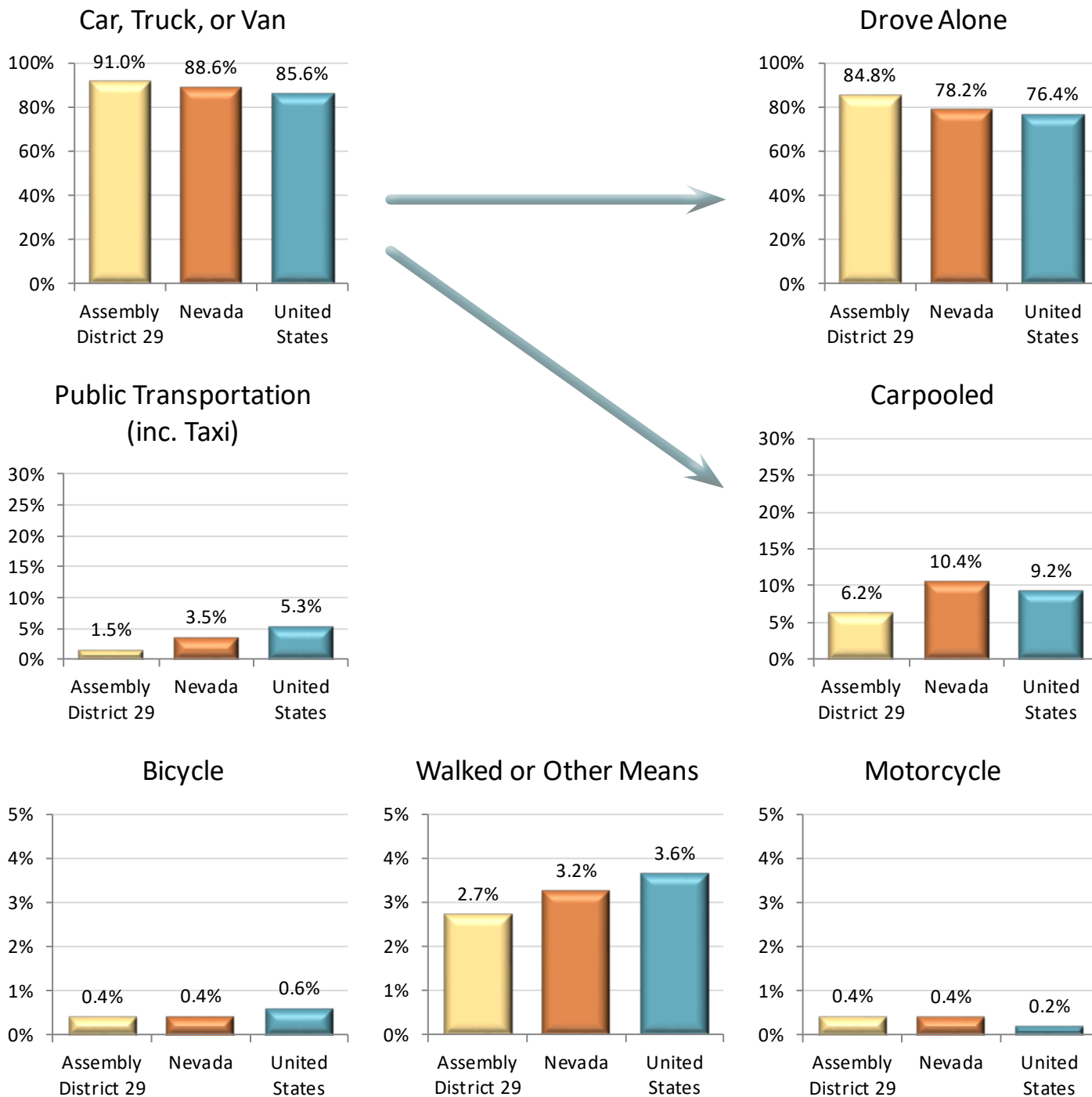

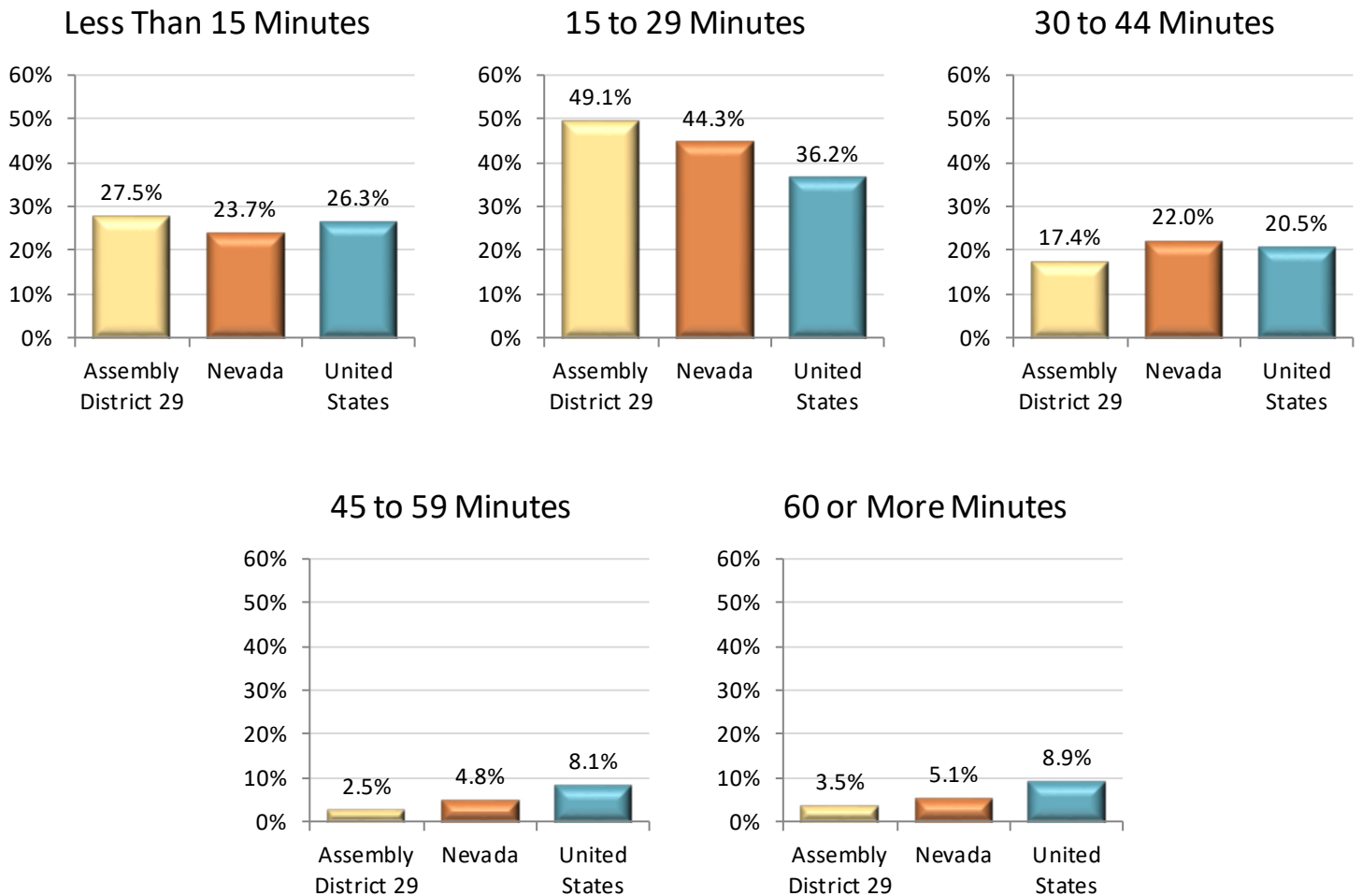

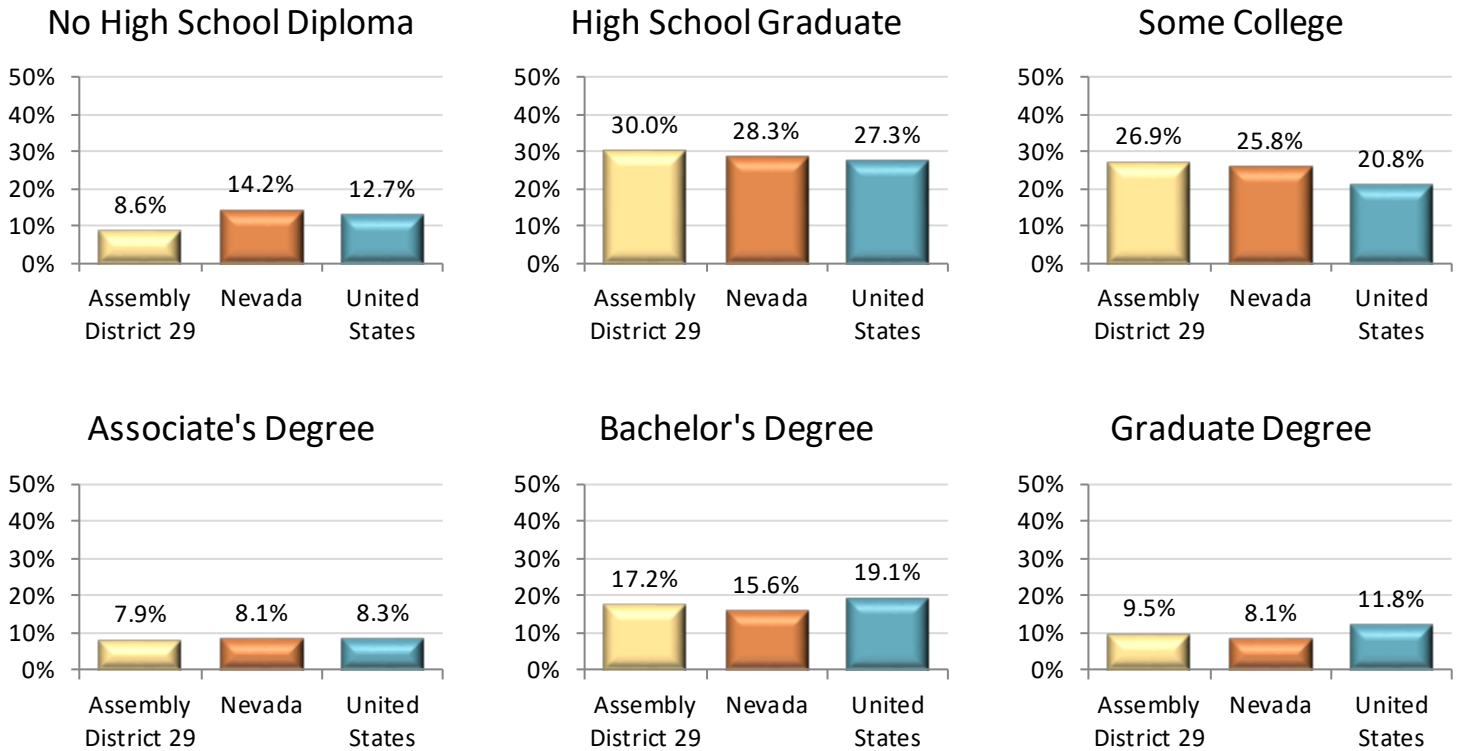

Chart 23—Percent Uninsured

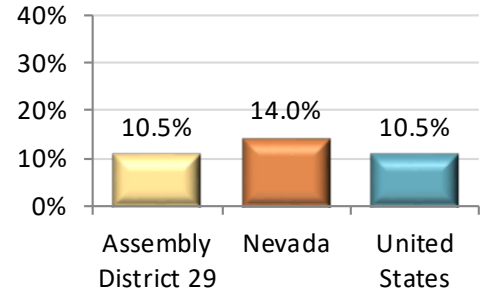
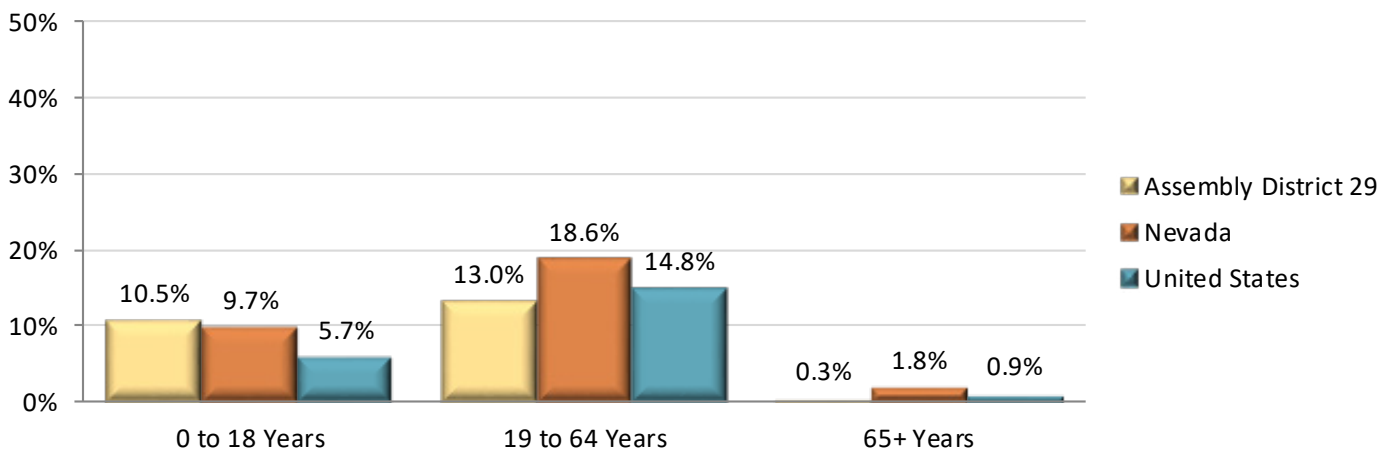

Chart 25—Percentage of Employed Who Are Uninsured

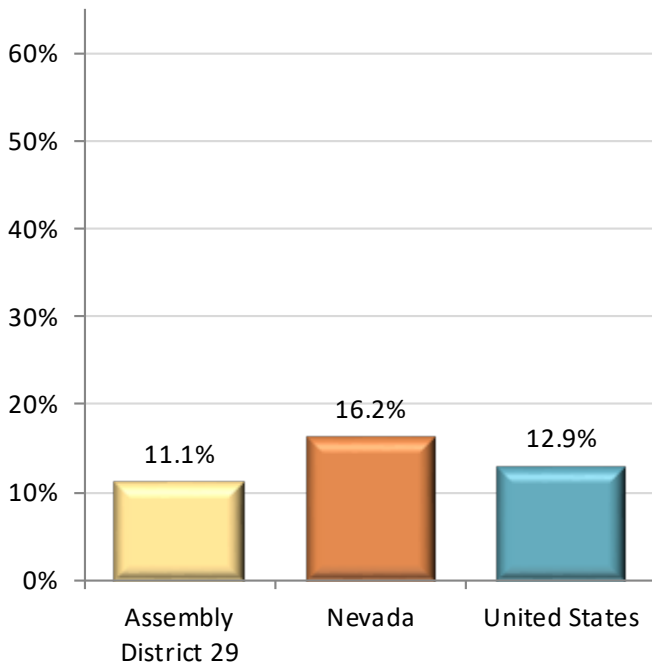
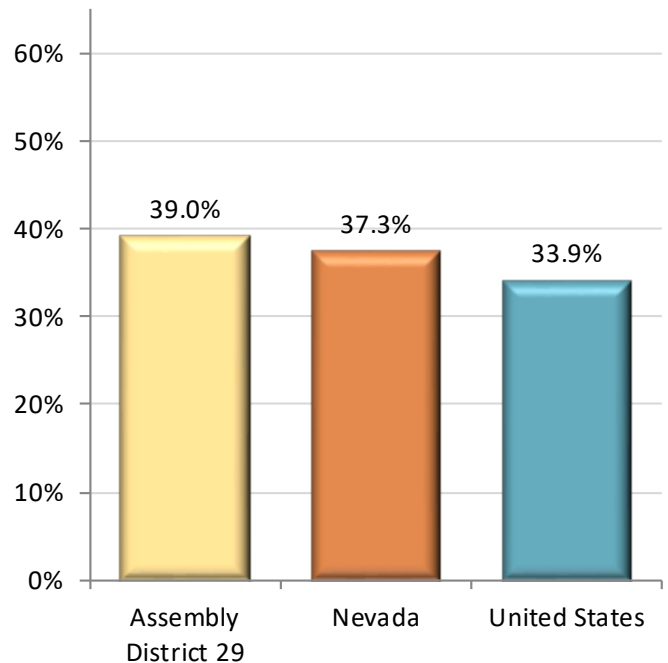


Chart 26—Percentage of Unemployed Who Are Uninsured

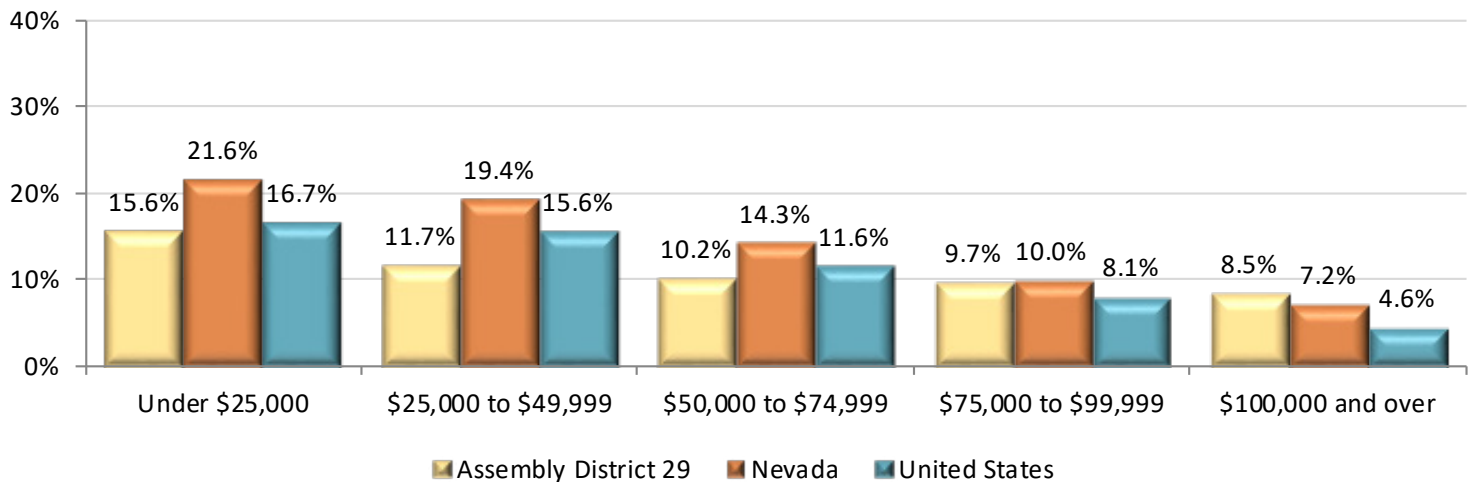

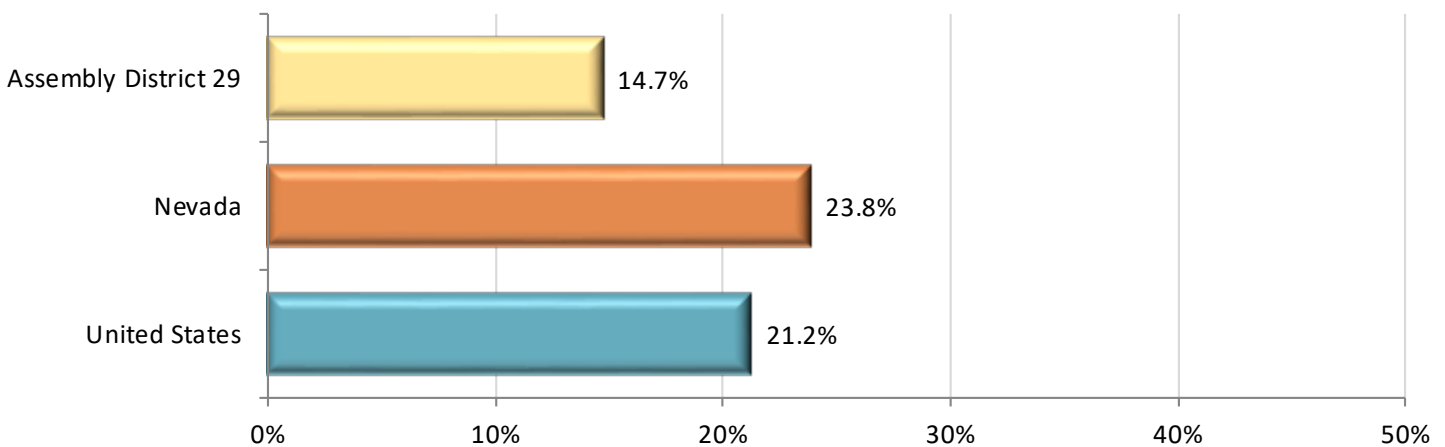

Chart 29—Occupied Housing Units

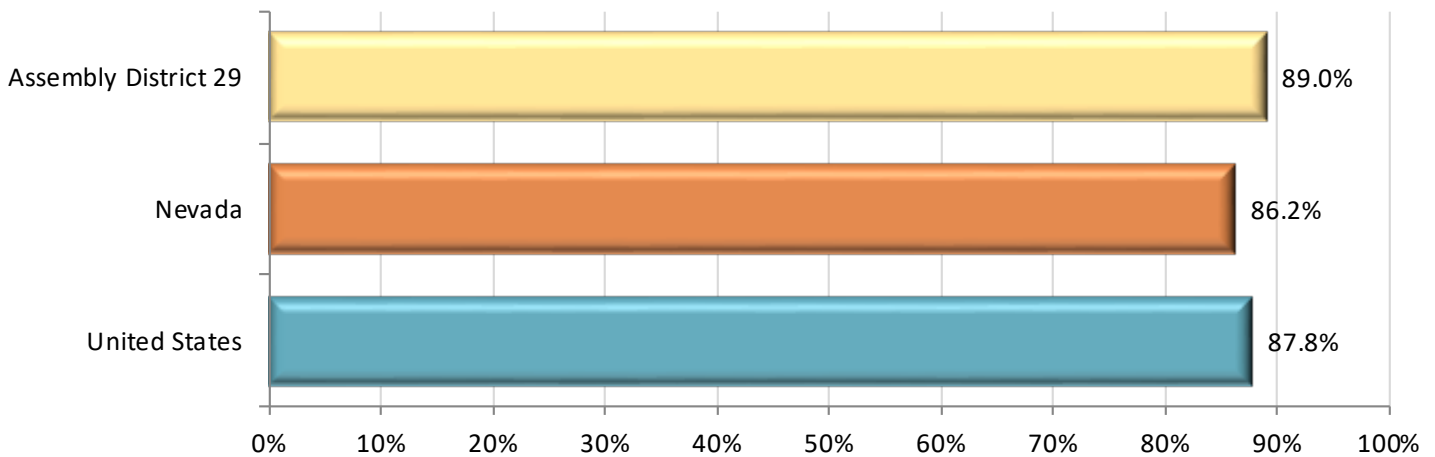


Chart 30—Owner Occupied Housing Units

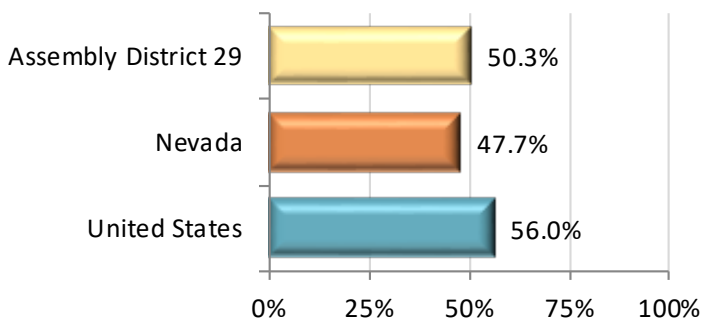
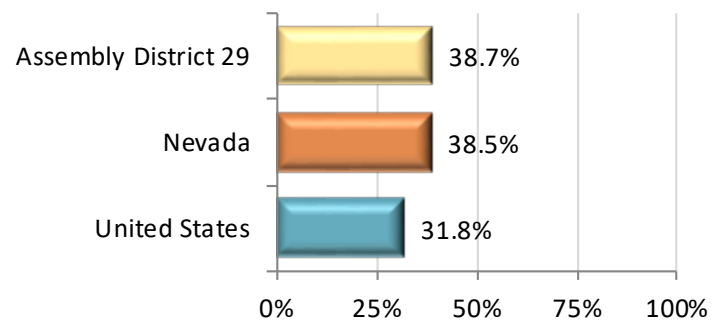


Chart 31—Renter Occupied Housing Units

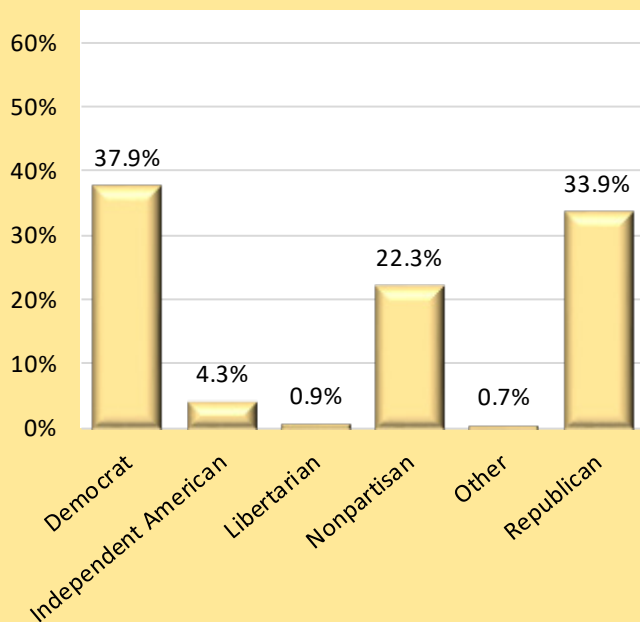
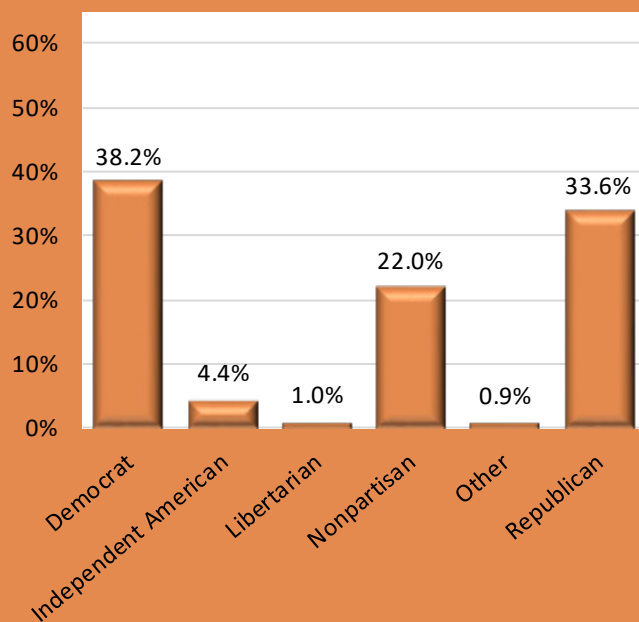


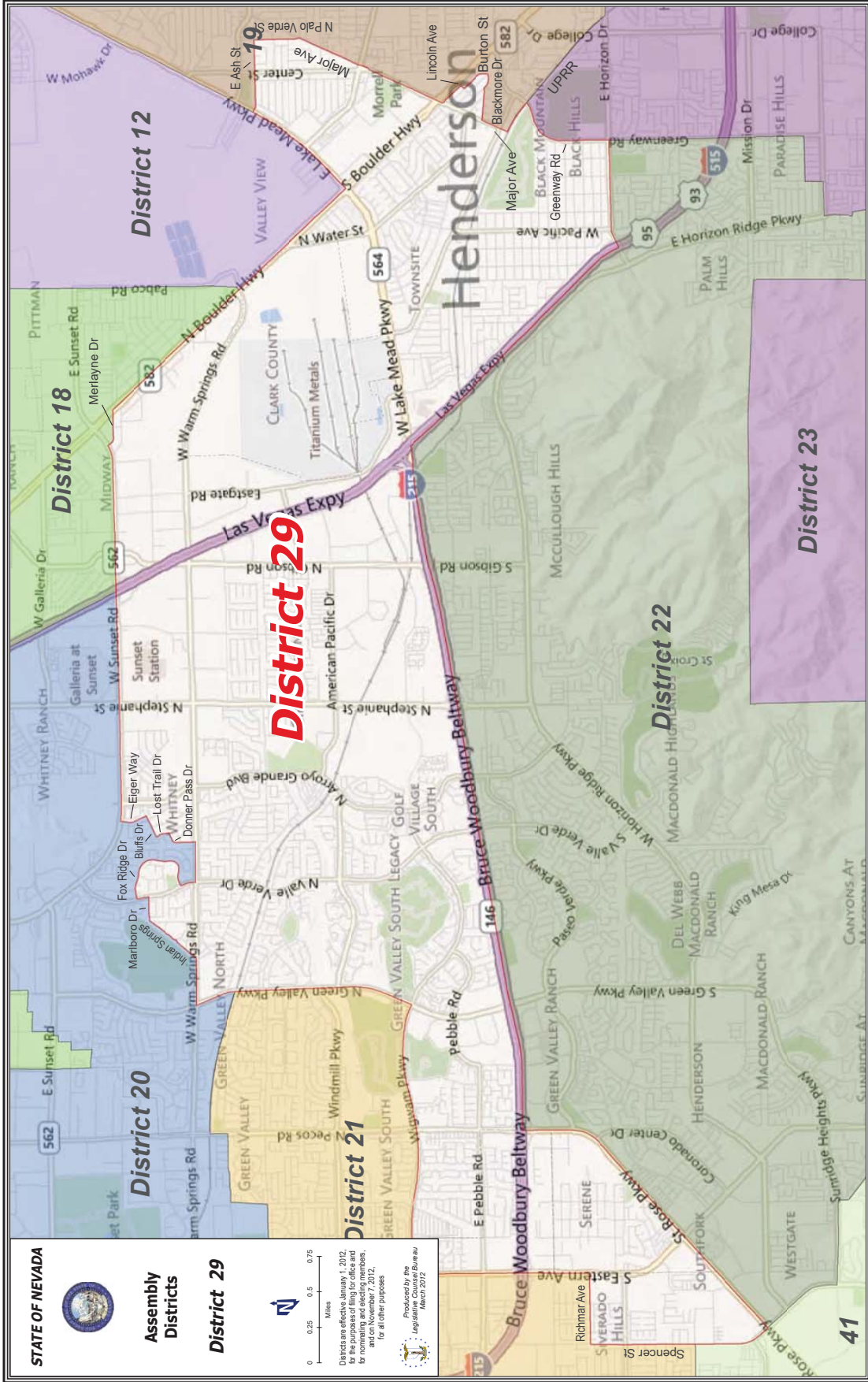
Chart 33—Nevada
