ASSEMBLY BILL 19

Bill makes it mandatory for officer in charge to allow public inspection of any records or books in his custody. Makes violation a misdemeanor.

Nr. Close referred to the original legislation on this, found that it had been put on the books in 1911 and that it did not include any definition of what constitutes public records. He, therefore, appointed Mr. Kean and Mr. Swobe to make a further study of this original statute and report findings.

BILLS GIVEN TO CONMITTEE FOR CONMITTEE APPROVAL AND INTRODUCTION

BDR 16-429 (A.B. 82)

Regulates purchases of hand guns--waiting period of 72 hours--bill was in the governor's message.

Move to introduce the bill as a committee bill, without responsibility for defending it when it comes back, was passed unanimously.

BDR 16-9 (A.B. 83)

Pertains to mail, telephone, and door to door advartising being included with other types of advertising in the restraints, etc., pertaining to the other types of advertising.

Move to introduce passed unanimously.

BOR 10-4 (A.B. 80)

Pertains to sub-division of lands.

Move to introduce passed unanimously.

Meeting adjourned 10:10 A.M.

BDR 8-3.", regulating installment sales of goods and services, including vehicles, was also considered, and the move to introduce it passed unanimously.
