MINUTES OF MEETING OF JUDICIARY COMMITTEE, 53rd LEGISLATURE, Jan. 21, 1965 Meeting commenced at 9:20 A.M.

Present: Close, Parsons, Rosaschi, Delaney, Jacobsen, Kean, Knisley, Swobe, Olsen Minutes of previous meeting examined and approved.

Mr. Close announced that we are considering meeting in the other, larger room.

Mr. Swobe gave the report which had been assigned to Swobe and Kean on <u>Assembly Bill 19</u>. It was concluded that items, such as divorce, adoptions, etc., which had been sealed in the previous action would remain sealed under this bill.

Move to introduce passed unanimously.

Mr. Close read proposed Rules of Procedure for Committee on Judiciary. The Rules of Procedure were adopted unanimously.

AB 23 Move to introduce was passed unanimously.

AB 35 Referred by Ed Fike. This bill was deferred until another similar bill reaches the Committee so that the two may be compared.

<u>AB 38</u> Referred by Valentine and Mello. Mr. Walentine was called in and questioned as to the purpose for the bill.

It was moved and passed unanimously that the bill be held in Committee and not reported to the floor.

<u>AB 48</u> This bill has to do with physical abuse of children having to be reported to legal authorities by doctors and nurses who treat such cases. It was suggested that this law might deny medical aid to children as parents might not take them in for medical care if they were going to be reported.

It was moved that Mr. Close would contact Judge Mowbray who originated the bill to see what his views might be on this aspect of the situation.

Motion passed unanimously.

BDR 37-215 Bill has to do with Veteran's Quarters.

Move to introduce passed unanimously.

Committee adjourned 9:50 A.M.
