A proposal to radically alter the urban renewal program with state legislation, and a distinction between matters to be handled by select committees of the delegations affected, and issues of state-wide significance requiring action of this committee.

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The members of the committee being composed of nine persons, and seven being in attendance, it was determined that a forum was present for the purpose of conducting the business of the committee.

Discussions were had regarding meeting of the committee and it was tentatively suggested that the hour of 3:00 p.m. be adopted subject to the later action of the committee.

It was moved by Mr. McKissick and unanimously passed that the Chairman be instructed to obtain a secretary for the purpose of recording all proceedings of this committee. Mr. McKissick served on this committee in former sessions and indicated it would have a great volume of business requiring the testimony of a number of e xpert witnesses.

Mr. Homer appeared for the purpose of explaining <u>AB No. 5</u> which he prepared in collaboration with Mr. Jacobsen. Since formal printed copies of the bill were not available, it was decided to defer action on <u>AB No. 5</u> until tomorrow during some recess when it would be hoped the matter could be disposed of.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned upon motion of Mr. Garfinkle.

STANDING RULES - COMMITTEE ON STATE, COUNTY, AND CITY AFFAIRS - 54TH LEGISLATURE, 1967.

1. A quorum will consist of five members.

2. Affirmative vote of five members will be required for any action by the committee.

3. To pass or hold a bill or resolution will require the affirmative vote of five members.

4. To amend a bill or to amend these rules will require the affirmative vote of five members.

5. The cause the committee to reconsider a tabled measure or matter will require the affirmative tote of six members.

6. The Chairman, Mr. Hilbrecht, will convene the meetings and hearing of the committee and preside. The Vice Chairman shall be Mr. Garfinkle, and he shall act in the absence of the Chairman. ADDENDUM TO STANDING RULES FOR THE ASSEMBLY COMMITTEE ON STATE,
