Chairman Hilbrecht opened the meeting at 1:00 p.m. and announced the new bills before the committee, namely <u>AB 220</u> and <u>AB 227</u>.

<u>AB 229</u>: This bill relating to urb to was deferred for hearing in conjunction with <u>AB 141</u> on rebruary 24.

<u>AB 227</u>: This bill relating to salaries of justices of the peace in Las Vegas was delegated to Mrs. Tyson for study and report back to the committee.

<u>AB 199 and AB 200</u>: Mr. McKissick reported that there is still disagreement between the court reporters of Clark and Washoe Counties. Chairman Hilbrecht asked that Mr. Wooster and Mr. McKissick confer with the interested parties and Speaker Mel Close and report back to the committee.

Chairman Hilbrecht was given the committee's approval to proceed with the legislative counsel in preparation of a concurrent joint resolution that would effect a study of and formalized resolve for the problems arising from merger or consolidation of political subdivisions within the State to be reported back to the 55th Session of the Nevada Legislature.

Chairman Hilbrecht announced that the Friday, February 17 would be conducted by Vice Chairman Bud Garfinkle and that Mr. Art Palmer and a representative of the Southern Pacific Railroad would be present for discussion of <u>AB 28</u>, the uniform time act bill.

Mr. Curt Blyth was introduced to acquaint the committee with two more proposals pending. BDR 21-656 is another matter that should be heard in connection with the publication bills that are still under consideration. Another measure involving ad valorem tax allocations will be available for hearing with the urban renewal bills. Also the annexation bill is being studied by the subcommittee composed of Mr. Smith, Mr. Dini, and Chairman Hilbrecht.

Mr. Smith asked that Mr. Wooster assist him in consideration of <u>AB 59</u> and the <u>Senate's SB 133</u> concerning the Municipal Airports Act.

Chairman Hilbrecht announced that <u>AB 167</u> is under subcommittee consideration and that objective of the bill may be arrived at by another approach.
