NEVADA STATE LEGISLATURE, 54TH SESSION

Meeting was called to order by Chairman Norman D. Glaser at 10:23 A.M. January 26, 1967 to consider emergency measures - SB 36, <u>37</u> and <u>38</u>.

Howard Barrett and Bob Bruce present. Also Jim Jefferson, Purchasing Agent, University; Albert Seeliger, Board of Regents; Reporters. <u>SB 37</u> - authorizing bonding - eliminating duplication and so-called "boiler plate" in subsequent bills.

Mr. Bowler moved "Do Pass." Mr. Jacobsen seconded motion. Passed unanimously.

 \underline{SB} - authorizes issuance of state's general obligation bonds for construction of chemistry and lecture buildings at Reno campus of University of Nevada.

Mr. Young moved "Do Pass." Seconded by Mr. Bowler. Passed unanimously.

<u>SB 36</u> - authorizes University of Nevada to issue revenue bonds for phase I construction of chemistry and lecture demonstration buildings of the physical science building project on the Washoe County campus.

Mr. Ashworth moved "Do Pass," seconded by Mr. Bowler.

Mr. Jacobsen made motion to investigate about \$42.00 fee. Discussion. Mr. Ashworth said he believed Committee should go on record not to forget to tie down the \$42.00 student fee and to do something before session is over. Discussion by Mr. Glaser.

Mr. Bowler moved that we follow through on the above, seconded by Mr. Jacobsen. Mr. Glaser said " It has been moved and seconded that we follow up on some sort of action expressing concern of the method of funding from student fees." Mr. Jacobsen - "Question." Passed unanimously.
