SENATE COMMITTEE ON FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS

Minutes of Meeting Held March 6, 1967

The 15th meeting of the Senate Committee on Federal, State, and Local Governments was called to order at 1:00 p.m. on Monday, March 3, 1967, in Committee Room 50, State Capitol, by Chairman Gibson.

All committee members were present.

The Chairman stated he had received a request for additional time on <u>Senate Bills 151</u> and <u>199</u> introduced by Senator Young and that these will be heard on Wednesday, March 8, at 1:00 p.m.

S.B. 193: Authorizes political subdivisions to pay 100% of cost of premiums for public employees' group insurance and medical services. Introduced by Senator Alleman.

Discussion.

<u>Disposition:</u> Senator Hecht moved the committee kill the bill; Senator Bunker seconded. The vote was as follows: Aye - Gibson, Monroe, Bunker, Hecht, Young. No - Alleman, Farr.

The motion carried.

<u>S.B. 170</u>:

Authorizes counties and cities to issue revenue bonds to finance industrial development. Introduced by Senator Alleman.

<u>Disposition</u>: Awaiting additional information. Will try to act on this later this week.

<u>S.B. 47</u>: Provides for one member of California-Nevada Interstate Compact Commission actively interested in fish, wildlife, and recreation. Introduced by Senator Young.

Senator Young brought in amendment to provide that a commissioner be added and no commissioner be taken off, with eight voting commissioners to be appointed by the governor (and state engineer to remain as a nonvoting member).

Disposition: Senator Farr moved the adoption of the amendment; Senator Monroe seconded. The vote was as follows: Aye - Alleman, Farr, Monroe, and Young. No - Bunker, Gibson, Hecht.

The motion carried.



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Senator Farr moved the committee report the bill out with a "Do pass as amended" recommendation. Senator Alleman seconded. Discussion followed. Then the vote was as follows: Aye - Alleman, Farr, Monroe, Young. No - Bunker, Gibson, Hecht.

The motion carried.

S.J.R. 9: Proposes annual sessions of Legislature. Introduced by this committee.

Discussion.

Senator Monroe moved that the bill be amended to provide for 60-day annual sessions and do pass as amended; Senator Alleman seconded. The vote was as follows: Aye - Alleman, Farr, Bunker, Gibson, Monroe, and Young. No - Hecht.

The motion carried.

S.B. 228: Increases filing fees for State Senators and Assemblymen. Introduced by Senator Herr.



Senator Monroe moved that the committee kill the bill; Senator Farr seconded; the motion passed unanimously.

S.B. 242: Authorizes sale of negotiable coupon bonds in fire protection districts created by boards of county commissioners. Introduced by Senator Farr.

Discussion.

Disposition: Senator Alleman moved "Do pass"; Senator Monroe seconded; motion passed unanimously.

S.B. 279: Authorizes Sparks city treasurer to use facsimile signature. Introduced by Senator Farr.

Discussion.

Disposition: Senator Bunker moved "Do pass"; Senator Monroe seconded; motion passed unanimously.

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<u>S.B. 287</u>: Amends North Las Vegas city charter to increase salaries of mayor and councilmen; requires publication of city's legal notices in newspaper published in city.

Discussion.

Disposition: Senator Gibson will draft amendment that will make the salary raises effective after present term of office of officers involved.

The Chairman announced the committee would meet the following day at 8:00 a.m.

The meeting adjourned at 1:55 p.m.
