April 13, 1967

The 41st meeting of the Senate Committee on Federal, State, and Local Governments was called to order on Thursday, April 13, 1967, at 1:00 p.m., in Committee Room 50, State Capitol, by the Chairman, Senator James I. Gibson.

All committee members were present except Senator Alleman.

The Chairman called for consideration of -

A.B. 537: Committee on State, County, and City Affairs. Proposes new annexation procedures for certain cities; reenacts prior annexation laws relating to towns and certain special districts.

Senator Gibson called on Mr. Blyth to explain the bill to the committee. Mr. Blyth went through the bill, explaining the purposes and applications of the various sections. He stated that Sections 2 - 21 are applicable to the cities in Clark County; that Sections 23 and 24 have to do with the changing of boundaries of unincorporated towns; that Sections 25 - 60 have to do with annexation procedures for various types of special districts (an attempt to restore special districts to their status prior to 1965); that Sections 61 - 90 are the provisions of present Chapter 242A (the 1965 annexation law) and apply to cities and counties other than Clark; and that Section 91 provides additional procedures in counties other than Clark. He discussed individual sections in some detail, receiving and answering questions from the committee as he went along.

DISPOSITION: The Chairman stated the committee would look this bill over further before taking action on it.

Senator Gibson next directed the committee's attention to -

A.B. 123: Brookman, Bishop, May, Hilbrecht, Bryan Hafen, Wilson, White, Mello, Harris, Garfinkle, Schouweiler, and Frazzini. Empowers political subdivisions to purchase disability insurance to guarantee salaries to disabled firemen.
