The Chairman called for consideration of -


A.B. 123: Brookman, Bishop, May, Hilbrecht, Bryan Hafen, Wilson, White, Mello, Harris, Garfinkle, Schouweiler, and Frazzini.

Mr. Ashworth commented on the purposes and mechanics of the bill. Discussion followed. Mr. Ashworth and one other person left the meeting at 1:25 p.m.

A.B. 537: Committee on State, County, and City Affairs. Proposes new annexation procedures for certain cities; reenacts prior annexation laws relating to towns and certain special districts.

Discussion centered on Section 91, and particularly the definition of the word "contiguous". (Senator Bunker entered the meeting during this discussion, at 1:25 p.m.) The Chairman stated he had been given an amendment to page 10, lines 19-37, having to do with the procedure in annexing portions of an unincorporated town. This was discussed. The Chairman said he had also been given another amendment, suggested for page 6 of the bill, restoring criteria established in Chapter 242.

At this point the Senate was called back into session, and the meeting recessed at 1:40 p.m., to be resumed later in the day. However, the meeting was not resumed this date.
