MINUTES OF MEETING - WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE - NEVADA STATE LEGISLATURE.

1968 SPECIAL SESSION - FEBRUARY 8, 1968

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Glaser at 1:40 PM in the Ways and Means Room.

Mr. Glaser said that unless the committee requested it, there would be no more hearings on AB 3 or Dr. Homer's bill. He had talked with Mr. Larson on the cost figures - the basic grant of \$50,000; equipment and materials - \$29,000; and the feasibility study - \$17,500.

Mr. Larson indicated to him that in the event that money becomes a problem, some talent existing in the University could probably be utilized - Jack Davis or Dr. Tucker. They would just have to pay their expenses such as travel. They could also pull some federal grant money that comes into the University for research.

Mr. Glaser recommended to the committee that they leave in the feasibility study, but pull out the \$17,500 funding for it and have it taken care of as mentioned above. He had an amendment drawn to this effect.

Discussion on the equipment and material money. There had been indications from the labor group that they could help in this area. Discussion on the need for new and up-to-date machinery to use in the training. Mr. Glaser suggested that if the organized labor wanted to help, they could get some of the equipment that was knocked off the initial list of \$82,000. Discussion on this equipment going to the school district if the program was not continued. Labor also indicated help via scholarships.

The amendment was gone over. It amended section 9, page 3, by deleting lines 10 through 13 and inserting: #2. the monies appropriated under sub-..; amended section 9, page 3, deleting lines 16 through 18 and inserting: approved by the state board of education, as other claims against the state are paid; amended section 10, page 3, by deleting lines 22 and 23 and inserting: Section 10. Section 8 of this act and other sections of this act inasfar as they require....

AB 3: Establishes pilot project for community colleges.

Mr. Young moved that the amendment be adopted. Mrs. Tyson seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Young moved that AB 3 as amended be reported out with a DO PASS. Mr. Jacobsen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Meeting adjourned at 1:50 PM.
