SENATE EDUCATION COMMITTEE

February 20, 1968

A meeting of the Senate Education Committee was called to order by Chairman, Procter Hug, on February 20, 1968 at 1:40 p.m. in Room 56 of the State Capitol Building.

All members of the Senate Education Committee were present.

Discussion was held regarding amending Senate Bill 18, Paragraph (f), subsection (3) as follows: By deleting the words, "Before acting on any such application, the state board of education shall determine the amount available in the state distributive school fund for distribution under this paragraph, and shall make no distribution in excess of such amount." and by adding the words, "Before acting on any such application, the state board of education and state board of examiners, jointly, shall determine the difference between the total amount of dollars appropriated and authorized for expenditure during the biennium from the distributive school fund and the total of estimated requirements subject to payment under paragraph (c) and (e) of this sub-section, and shall make no distribution in excess of such difference."


Motion was made by Senator Bunker to amend Senate Bill 18 in accordance with the foregoing.

Motion seconded by Senator Titlow.

Senate Bill 18 was passed out with the recommendation of do pass as amended.

Chairman Hug adjourned the meeting at 1:50 p.m.
