After calling the meeting to order, Chairman Floyd R. Lamb continued the reading of the Amendments to <u>Senate Bill No. 9</u>, starting with Amendment 1297.

Discussion began on the wording in Section 3, Page 8, Line 12 concerning deletion of "either state" and insertion of "the State of Nevada".

Assemblyman Hilbrecht requested that the language be limited to the Nevada situation. He said it seemed good sense to him to let California come to grips with the problem themselves. He stated Z'berg advised him this was of great significance.

Discussion followed as to whether the bill should read the way it was because it had been so approved by California. Senators Lamb and Franzway said they did not feel that writing the bill to please California was the way to do it.

Senator Lamb made the motion the wording be left as it is.

Senator Pozzi seconded the motion.

Motion that wording of the amendment remain the same carried unanimously (1297).
