February 20, 1968

A meeting of the Senate Finance Committee was called to order by Chairman Floyd R. Lamb on February 20, 1968 at 1:50 p.m. in Room 50 of the State Capitol Building.

A short discussion took place regarding the gentleman's agreement regarding placing emergency funding before an interim committee if the amount of the requested fund was \$50,000 or in excess thereof.

Senator Fransway stated he would like for emergency funding to be handled as it has always been handled, in other words, come to the Legislature when the need was there.

Senator Brown said the suggestion has merit and said the Senate Finance Committee must rely on the gentleman's agreement regarding the \$50,000 or over request.

Senator Brown said, "I make the motion that we adopt it as suggested."

Senator Titlow seconded the motion.

The vote was 5 to 2 with Senators Fransway and Slattery dissenting.

Senator Gibson made a motion that the amendment of subsection 3 of paragraph (f) be approved, which clarifies the amount of money that may be used for emergencies by the Department of Education.


Senator Brown seconded the motion.


The vote was 5 to 2 with Senators Fransway and Slattery dissenting.
