SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE

February 24, 1968

A meeting was called of the Senate Finance Committee in Room 50, State Capital Building by Chairman Floyd Lamb at 11:00 a.m. for theconsideration of Assembly Bill No. 26 and Assembly Bill No. 25.

All members of the Senate Finance Committee were present.

Chairman Floyd Lamb began themeeting by asking Assemblyman Glaser to explain why they wanted the position of Park Engineer changed from an unclassified position to a classified position.

Assemblyman Glaser replied that he felt putting the man in the Civil Service position was in the best interests of Government; also that for the salary offered they could do better. Raising the salary from \$9500 to \$11,142 was to cover travel expenses and also to cover retirement fees etc.,

Senator Brown made the motion the bill be passed.

Senator Titlow seconded the motion.

Assembly Bill No. 26 passed unanimously

Mr. Glaser was then asked about <u>Assembly Bill No. 25</u>, and his reasons for the change in this one. He replied that Child Welfare was the one program that could not be carried over by drawing on next year's fund, and would be the program that would suffer if the \$50,000 was not allotted; therefore, the Child Welfare Program should be put in the same categories as the other programs.

Senator Gibson made the motion that the bill be passed.

Senator Brown seconded the motion.

Assembly Bill No. 25 passed unanimously.
