Senator Hug opened the meeting by stating the purpose and intent of the meeting was for consideration of the Recommendations of the Superintendent of Public Instruction for Amendments to Senate Bill No. 5.

Senator Lamb stated there were some possible changes that might work to better advantage in Senate Bill No. 5, and basically these changes would set up guidelines for use of emergency funding.

Senator Brown entered the meeting at 10:55.

Mr. Lincoln Liston of the Department of Education pointed out in the suggested amendments that Paragraph E had been reworded; Paragraph F had been added and that Sections 1 through 8 had been wiped out. He also called attention to subparagraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), (e) and (f) under Section 9, as containing information clarifying the position of the Department of Education.

After discussion, the Committees agreed to study the recommendations and to meet Monday for a lengthier discussion of the amendments.

Chairman Hug adjourned the meeting at 11:05 a.m.
