MINUTES OF MEETING - WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE - NEVADA STATE LEGISLATURE

55th SESSION

The meeting was called to order by Chairman R. Young at 12:30 P.M. in the Ways and Means Committee Room.

Mr. Frank Young questioned the reduction in salary of the Director of the Office of Economic Opportunity. He wondered if the Committee felt their action was properly considered.

Mr. Ashworth made a motion to approve the Unclassified Salaries.

Mr. Jacobsen seconded the motion.

Motion carried.

Mr. Frank Young voted no.

Public Service Commission

Mr. Howard made certain recommendations for Classified positions. He felt that the Principal Auditor, 2nd year, Three Field Investigators, Electrical Engineer, III, and a Utility Tariff Clerk should be left in the Budget.

Mr. Webb moved that the Committee approve the Public Service Commission's Budget as recommended by Mr. Howard. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Frank Young suggested that Chairman R. Young write a letter to the Public Service Commission Employees Reliver regarding the effect of S.B. 479 Which provides retirement allowances and beneficiary protection for public employees who terminate public employment after 15 or 20 years of service prior to reaching retirement age, and request them to report next session the results of the study back to the Ways and Means Committee.

S.B. 191 Increases vehicle registration fee for benefit of Nevada highway patrol.

Mr. Ashworth moved that S.B. 191 be reported out with a DO PASS.

Mr. Glaser seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
