Assembly MINUTES OF MEETING - WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE - NEVADA STATE LEGISLATURE

APRIL 20, 1969

55th SESSION

The meeting was called to order by Chairman R. Young at 12:20 P.M. in the Ways and Means Room.

R. Young, Howard, Bowler, Ashworth, Jacobsen. Present: Webb, Close

Absent: Frank Young, Glaser

A.B. 797 General Appropriation Act for 1969-71.

Mr. Earl Oliver reviewed this bill with Committee members. He stated that it is the general fund appropriations for almost all of the Budgets reviewed and approved by the Committees. The total for the biennium in this bill is \$88,651,286 general fund. \$9,160,261 is Highway Fund and \$40,000 Fish and Game Fund.

Mr. Close asked that the Fiscal Analyst give Committee members a breakdown on this bill.

Mr. Oliver also indicated that the school appropriation of \$79,058,000 would be in a separate bill.

A.B. 798 Summary - For 1969-70 would be \$104,149,880, for 1970-71, \$104,539,246 and the total for both years would be \$208,689,126.

Mr. Close questioned the wording on page 6, Section 4 of the bill. He wondered if line 20 has been changed from previous years.

Mr. Oliver commented that it had. The words "from any other appropriation" have been removed this time. Although it was never used by the Department of Administration it appeared to give them authority to move general fund appropriations.

Mr. Webb moved that A.B. 798 be reported out with a DO PASS. Mr. Bowler seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Bowler moved that A.B. 797 be reported out with a DO PASS. Mr. Jacobsen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

S.B. 534 Authorizes state general obligation bond commission to issue securities for designated facilities and provides for their acquisition; makes appropriation to state general obligation bond commission fund - \$25,000 appropriation \$6,500,000 bond authority.

Mr. Webb moved that S.B. 534 be reported out with a DO PASS. Mr. Bowler seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

It was recommended that <u>S.B. 538</u> be held for the amendment.

S.C.R. 31 Authorizes additional expenditure from legislative fund by joint committee appointed to investigate municipal financing.

Mr. Ashworth moved that <u>S.C.R. 31 be reported out with</u> <u>a DO PASS</u>. <u>Mr. Bowler seconded the motion</u>. Motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Roy Young commented that Senator Lamb indicated that the Senate Finance Committee has taken out the \$500,000 in Title XIX Budget, but left the services in.

Mr. Webb moved to put back all the Services of the Title XIX Program but not to restore the money originally deleted. Mr. Jacobsen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 12:50 P.M.

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
