MINUTES OF MEETING - WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE - NEVADA STATE LEGISLATURE

APRIL 7, 1969

55th SESSION

The meeting was called to order by Chairman R. Young at 11:55 A.M. in the Ways and Means Committee Room.

Mr. Jim Bailey, Mr. Shute and Mr. Hall were present to speak on  $\underline{S.B.}$  80 Which raises the fee for certifying that certain mobile home equipment is properly installed.

Mr. Shute stated that they want a code on a Statewide basis.

Mr. Bailey commented that in 1967 a bill was passed but with no funds for enforcement. One man would be needed as a trailer expert to inspect the trailers' plumbing, heating, and electrical systems. Amount requested would be \$10,500 and extras, such as costs of decals, printing, postage, etc. Mr. Bailey stated that 20% of their time should be spent in this area.

Mr. Hall noted that the seal which is to be placed on the trailer is a certification from the manufacturer saying that the trailer is built to standards. He also stated that \$2 was not sufficient to administer this work. They want to cooperate with the Department of Motor Vehicles.

A.B. 626 Provides for the conduct of hunter safety programs; makes appropriation from general fund.

Mr. Howard moved that A.B. 626 be postponed indefinitely.

Mr. Glaser seconded the motion.

<u>S.B. 476</u> Creates donated commodities revolving fund for purchasing division; abolishes school lunches revolving fund.

Mr. Glaser moved that A.B. 476 be reported out with a DO PASS.

Mr. Jacobsen seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Howard moved to increase the Out-of-District Travel \$2,420 each year.

Mr. Ashworth seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

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Mr. Glaser moved to approve the <u>District Judges Travel</u> as amended. Mr. Jacobsen seconded the motion.
Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Ashworth is to get amendements on  $\underline{S.B.}$  470 Which increases compensation of elected state officers, justices of Supreme Court and District Judges.

Mr. Glaser moved to delete the  $\underline{\text{Urban Planning Budget.}}$  Mr. Ashworth seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Mr. Henry Etchemendy, County Manager, and County Commissioner, Keith McDonald were present to speak on A.B. 600 Which relieves County Recorders of duties relating to marriage certificates.

Mr. Etchemendy stated that they would like to keep it within the Counties. Last year \$9,000 was made on recordations and duplications. Many people write to the County in which they were married and not to the State for duplicates.

Mr. Russ McDonald was asked to discuss the Bond and Investment Commission.

Mr. McDonald stated that the Bond and Investment Commission Budget does not require provisions for employee as  $\underline{S.B. 94}$  states the State Board of Finance may employ a financial Secretary. Provisions should be made in the State Board of Finance Budget. There is \$25,000 in the Bond and Investment Commission Budget for bond expense. This could be appropriated separately in the bond act.

Mr. Ashworth moved to delete the <u>Bond and Investment Commission</u>. Mr. Bowler seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Mr. Close moved that  $\underline{A.B.}$  600 be reported out with a DO PASS as amended. Mr. Ashworth seconded the motion.

Motion passed.

Mr. Jacobsen and Mr. Webb voted no.

Mr. Webb moved to approve the Education Administration as recommended.

Mr. Jacobsen seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Glaser moved to accept the Care of Deaf and Blind as recommended.

Mr. Webb seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Glaser moved to accept the Vocational Education's Budget as recommended.

Mr. Webb seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Webb moved to take out the  $\underline{\text{Vocational Special State Aid Budget}}$  and put it in the Education Fund.

Mr. Glaser seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

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Mr. Glaser moved to accept the <u>Gen. University Administration and Expense Budget</u> as amended.

Mr. Webb seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Glaser moved to accept the Reno Campus Instruction as amended.

Mr. Webb seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. F. Young moved to accept the Las Vegas Campus Instruction as amended.

Mr. Bowler seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Glaser moved to approve a separate Budget for <u>Computer Center</u> and have the Budget available to the Committee if possible.

Mr. Webb seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Howard moved to put \$839,931 the first year and \$889,679 the second year in Statewide Services and D.R.I.

Mr. Ashworth seconded the motion.

Motion passed.

Mr. Webb voted no.

Mr. Webb moved that Classified and <u>Technical Salary Adjustment</u> be approved as recommended.

Mr. Ashworth seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Webb moved that <u>S.B. 279 be reported out with a DO PASS</u> with the "Commission" deleted and State Board of Education be inserted and the sum of \$25,000 to the higher education student loan fund account inserted and deleted from the Governor's Budget.

Mr. Ashworth seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.
