After a brief review of each bill, the committee voted as follows:

A.B. 235 Requires fiscal analyst to prepare study of cash flow of public moneys to minimize amount in active deposits.

Do Pass.

A.B. 397 Exempts real estate broker from certain business license requirements.

Do Pass.

A.B. 404 Provides for arbitration with respect to uninsured motorist coverage.

Do Pass, as amended.
