

AGRICULTURE COMMITTEE 56th ASSEMBLY SESSION

MINUTES OF JANUARY 28, 1971. MEETING HELD IN ROOM #320.

MEMBERS PRESENT: CHAIRMAN: Virgil Getto, Roy Young, Norman
Glaser, Frances Hawkins.

Chairman Getto called the meeting to order at the hour of 9:55 a.m.

Chairman Getto introduced the following rules of procedure.

1. Majority or 4 votes to pass.
2. Two-thirds vote, or five to reconsider bill.
3. Daily minutes to be presented at following meeting.
4. Simple majority to introduce legislation.
5. Held for further consideration; introduction of bill after 40 days.

There was no objection from the Committee about the aforesaid rules.

Mr. Glaser made a motion to adopt proposed rules. The motion was seconded by Mr. Young. Motion carried.

Chairman Getto read the summary on the following four bills.

Mr. Glaser moved that the bills be given Committee introduction. Seconded by Miss Hawkins. Motion carried.
