Mr. Glaser will contact the Department of Conservation and Natural Resorces regarding a hearing Tuesday February 18, after Assembly a.m. recess.

AB 118: Changes composition of State Dairy Commission

There will be a hearing on Thursday February 18, after Assembly a.m. recess.

AB 172: Summary: Requires prepackaged meat to bear USDA grade.

AB 122: Summary: Make sale, distribution, and use of DDT unlawful.
