Chairman Swallow called the meeting to order at 11:00 A.M. for the purpose of discussing:

SB 390: Permits disposal of certain school district records.

SB 223: Permits school trustees to realize appreciation in value of certain lands when sold.

SB 205: Provides for payment of educational expenses of all aurally and visually handicapped persons at request of school trustees.

Discussion was held on SB 223 and it was explained that this would allow school districts to sell public land which they had been holding to build on. It would have to be offered first to the original owner and if he did not take the option to others at appraisal plus the interest that had been paid.

Miss Hawkins moved to do pass SB 223.

Mr. Wilson seconded the motion.

Motion carried.

Mr. Gamble explained the purpose of SB 205. He said that as it stands now parents of handicapped children who could afford it had to stand the full expense of sending their handicapped child to a school outside of the state whereas poorer people had all expenses paid. This bill would alleviate some of the expense for these people.

Mrs. Frazzini moved to do pass SB 205.

Mrs. White seconded the motion.

Motion carried.

Miss Foote moved to do pass SB 390.

Miss Hawkins seconded the motion.

Motion carried.

Discussion was held on AB 224. No action taken as yet.
