- <u>AB 33</u> open discussion; Mr. Dreyer was appointed to contact with counsel about legality.
- <u>AB 34</u> it was proposed that the polls open at 7:00 A.M. and close at 7:00 P.M., statewide.
- <u>AB 51</u> Mr. Young suggested a system whereby the Legislature provides the wording that goes on the ballet, and the summary should be made a part of the resolution the committee passes. Further discussion, and Mr. Young's suggestions are approved. The bill is postponed until omnibus comes out. Discussion; Mr. Young was appointed to review the Bill.
