Mr. Mulroy suggested on <u>AB 62</u> to strike Polling place and put in voting room in its place. The Committee disagreed with the suggestion and there was a unanimous vote by the Committee to leave it as polling place.

Mr. Nick Lauri reported on 293.165; Section 2:

"I talked with Mr. McDonald and he says we can go the route we are proposing, whereas a non-partisan office vacancy could be filled pursuant to statutes, that being the vacancy of the
