

ELECTIONS COMMITTEE: 56TH ASSEMBLY SESSION:

MINUTES OF MARCH 24, 1971

MEMBERS PRESENT: CHAIRMAN: Marv Frazzini, Frank Young, Darel Drever, Juanita White, Nick Lauri, Marge Foote.

Chairman Frazzini called the meeting to order at the hour of 8:10 a.m.

AB 426: was the first order of business before the committee:

Mr. Drever presented his amendment to AB 426, the committee had discussion of the amendment and made the following change;

(SEE ATTACHED AMENDMENT) DELETED; ON THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT, THE LINE THAT SAYS: AMEND SECTION 31 PAGE 4 BY DELETING LINES 4 THROUGH 10 AND INSERTING:

The committee decision was to amend and refer to the Election Committee. on page 4 lines 4 through 10, delete [commission] and add " county clerk"

ACR 3: Directs legislative commission to study campaign costs with view of regulating campaign expenditures.

MISS FOOT MOVED FOR INDEFINITE POSTPONEMENT, SECONDED, MOTION CARRIED FOR INDEFINITE POSTPONEMENT.

AB 17: Allows county conventions of political parties to be held at place other than county seat.

COMMITTEE DECISION: HOLD

AB 33: Requires absence to be considered on question of residence in determining eligibility for public office.

COMMITTEE DECISION:HOLD.

AB 34: Enlarges time for opening, closing polls in Carson City.

COMMITTEE DECISION: HOLD

AB 51: Permits condensed summaries of questions and constitutional amendments on ballots; permits county clerks to divide ballots

COMMITTEE DECISION: HOLD

AB 62: Clarifies description of polling place zone within which soliciting votes and electioneering are prohibited.

COMMITTEE DECISION: INDEFINATE POSTPONEMENT

AB 95: Defines "delegate" to state convention of political parties.

COMMITTEE DECISION: Frank Young moved for INDEFINATE POSTPONEMENT SECONDED. MOTION CARRIED

AB 350: Limits campaign expenses of legislators and requires disclosure of such expenses.

COMMITTEE DECISION: INDEFINATE POSTPONEMENT, NO OBJECTIONS MOTION CARRIED.

AB 450: Providing certain dates for state and county political conventions.

COMMITTEE DECISION: INDEFINATE POSTPONEMENT: HOLD

AB 554: Eliminates names and titles of unopposed candidates and offices from election ballot.

COMMITTEE DECISION: FRANK YOUNG MOVED FOR INDEFINATE POSTPONEMENT, SECONDED, MOTION CARRIED.

AB 565: Provides separate ballot for all purposed constitutional amendments and other propositions or questions.

COMMITTEE DECISION: FRANK YOUNG MOVED FOR INDEFINATE POSTPONEMENT, SECONDED, MOTION CARRIED.

AB 574: Creates election districts for county commissioners, school and hospital trustees in large counties.

COMMITTEE DECISION: NICK LAURI MOVED FOR INDEFINATE POSTPONEMENT, SECONDED, MOTION CARRIED.

AB 578: Prohibits anonymous political literature and regulates television and radio political broadcasting costs.

COMMITTEE DECISION: DAREL DREYER MOVED FOR INDEFINATE POSTPONEMENT, SECONDED BY MR. LAURI, MOTION CARRIED.

AB 649: Reapportions regents.

COMMITTEE DECISION: FRANK YOUNG MOVED FOR INDEFINITE POSTPONEMENT, SECONDED, MOTION CARRIED.

AB 736: Changes and limits terms of regents and changes board composition.

There was committee discussion on this bill, Mr. Young called the committee's attention to line 18 on page 2; which reads: In district No.2 one member shall be elected from each commissioner district." then on line 20 and 21 it says Residence within a commissioner district is not a requirement for filing in such district.

Mr. Young Stated that they were trying the English System, Constitutionally you have to live in your own district, Who knows having tried the system here it may take on, The people have to live within the County, but they don't have to live in the district.

Mr. Young stated the committee was misinterpreting the Court, what the court is saying is, that if you have 1000 whites and 500 blacks and your representation is 1 for every 500, don't make a 3 seat district because you will only get whites elected, seperately districted.
