MINUTES OF MARCH 25, 1971

MEMBERS PRESENT CHAIRMAN: Mary Frazzini, Frank Young, Ross Prince Juanita White, Darel Drever

Chairman Frazzini called the meeting to order at 8:15 a.m.

The following bills will be held by the committee; they concern reapportionment.

- <u>AB 770</u>: Provides for additional school trustee in Clark County.
- <u>AB 736</u>: Changes and limits terms of regents and changes board compositions.
- <u>AB 737</u>: Limits terms of members of state board of education and changes board composition.
- AJR 35: Memorializes Congress to enact legislation to allow certain franking privileges.

There was committee discussion and Mr. Prince moved to Do Pass, Mr. Young seconded, motion carried. DO PASS ON AJR 35:

SB 264: Provides for revote where voting machine malfunctions.

There was committee discussion and it was decided to have a hearing on this bill March 26, 1971 at the hour of 8:00 a.m. in room 222

<u>SB 291</u>: Increases period for candidates to change political party affiliation prior to primary election.

There was committee discussion, and Frank Young moved to Indefinately postpone, seconded, motion carried.

<u>SB 385:</u> Extends time for sending abstract of votes to Secretary of state.

There was no action on this bill at this time.

The committee appointed Mr. Drever to represent the committee in asking for a new bill regarding filing fees, which are to be as follows
