ELECTIONS COMMITTEE: 56TH ASSEMBLY SESSION

MINUTES OF MARCH 26, 1971

MEMBERS PRESENT: CHAIRMAN: Marv Frazzini, Frank Young, Nick Lauri,

Chairman Frazzini called the meeting to order at the hour of 8:10 a.m.

The first order of business before the committee was:

AJR 39: Ratifies proposed amendment to U. S. Constitution providing rights of citizens of United States who are 18 years of age or older to vote shall not be denied, abridged on account of age.

Mr. Drever moved a Do Pass, seconded, and committee then had discussion, Chairman Frazzini presented the question Do Pass, 4 ayes, 2 no, motion carried.

BDR 24-2131 ^{*} An act relating to elections; increasing the filing fees required of candidates for public office; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

*A.B. 793

There was committee discussion, and there no objections from the committee for Mrs. Frazzini to introduce this to the Assembly and re-refer to the election committee and put it out with a Do Pass.

SB 385: Extends time for sending abstracts of votes to secretary of state.

There was committee discussion of this bill and Mr. F. Young moved for Indefinite Postponement, seconded, motion carried.

SB 533: Corrects references to number of days allowed to make and transmit abstracts of votes.

There was committee discussion of this bill and Mr. Drever moved for Indefinite Postponement, seconded, motion carried.

SB 384: Clarifies petition requirements for independent candidates.

Miss Foote will research this bill for a similarity to another bill that was introduced.
