Chairman Homer called the meeting to order at 8:20 A.M.

Discussion was held on when the Committee on Environment and Public Resources should meet. It was decided that they would meet at 8:00 A.M. every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. If it is necessary for them to meet on Friday, the Chairman will notify committee members.

Chairman Homer requested that committee members study the following bills:

A.J.R. 3 - Proposes constitutional amendment to
add environmental bill of rights

A.B. 10 - Requires reports concerning nondegradable
detergents and prohibits their use

A.B. 29 - Provides private remedy of abatement in
air and water pollution matters

A.B. 37 - Establishes policy of State concerning
environmental quality

Getto asked that the rules and regulations be changed to include that for reconsideration of bills; it takes two-thirds majority vote of the committee. Motion by Swackhamer that the rules on procedures include that it takes two-thirds majority vote of the committee for reconsideration of bills. Seconded by Getto and carried.

Lowman stated that A.J.R. 3 was tied in with A.B. 37. Dr. Homer said it would take a constitutional amendment as a matter of policy. The Senate has two bills S.J.R. 4 and S.B. 20 which are identical to the two Assembly bills. There will be a hearing in the Senate on their two bills on Tuesday, February 2, 1971, in room 213. The Chairman will see that someone from the committee attends and check with Senator Wilson about holding a joint hearing.
