## FIFTY-SIXTH NEVADA ASSEMBLY SESSION

S.B. 99 "Provides minimum penalties for violation of fire-, tree-, and flora-protection laws."

S.B. 100 "Enables Division of Forestry to accept, sell, reforest, protect, donated lands adaptable for forest growth."

<u>S.B. 168</u> "Regulates logging or cutting operations on timberland and the conversion of such land to other uses."

Senator Swobe explained the purpose and intent of these bills.

Mr. Zappettini felt these bills were important and should be passed.

Mr. Bryan moved "do pass" on <u>S.B. 99, A.B. 100</u> and <u>S.B. 168</u>. Mr. Ronzone seconded. Motion carried.
