MINUTES OF MEETING - FISH AND GAME COMMITTEE - 56TH NEVADA ASSEMBLY SESSION



MARCH 23, 1971

PRESENT: Ronzone, May, Smith, Dreyer, Fry, and Olsen

ABSENT: Homer

OTHERS: Assemblyman Brookman

Chairman Ronzone called the meeting to order at 11:30 A.M. for the purpose of discussing A.B. 396, A.B. 442, and A.B. 451.

Discussion began on A.B. 442 which "Establishes title system for mctorboats." Chairman Ronzone commented that the proposed amendments were more or less "clean-up" amendments and also dealt with putting the registration on the hull. Mr. Dreyer moved a "do pass" as amended. Mr. May seconded. Motion carried.

With Mrs. Brookman present, discussion turned to A.B. 396 which "Extensively amends fish and game license, tag, and permit provisions, and hunting, fishing, and trapping laws." Mrs. Brookman again went over this bill and the proposed amendments. She said the Fish and Game Department had said they would not object to the \$1 fee or the 5-year residency or the inclusion of disabled veterans. The committee seemed to think that the Fish and Game Department had voiced some objection to this bill. It was decided, therefore, to hold this bill until a representative from the Department could be present and heard.

Mrs. Brookman did go on to say that, unfortunately, in this area, these people have a fixed income but everything else is going up around them. She felt they had earned these considerations. Mr. Smith commented that he did sympathize with Mrs. Brookman. Chairman Ronzone asked Mr. Fry if he had any objection to having disabled veterans included in this bill. He did not.

Mr. Olsen then explained A.B. 451 which "Changes regulation of zoos in certain counties from State to county." He also went over the proposed amendments to this bill. Mr. Smith moved to "do pass" this bill as amended. Mr. Dreyer seconded. Motion carried.

Discussion on A.B. 396 will continue on Thursday, March 25, with members of the Department of Fish and Game present.

Meeting adjourned at 11:55 A.M.
