ALL MEMBERS PRESENT

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith.

The Chairman stated that the meeting time would be on the quarter hour after PM adjournment. The committee will meet everyday except Friday, unless notified otherwise.

SB 54 - Authorizes Las Vegas Convention Authority in the name of Clark County to issue not to exceed \$7,500,000,of bonds for aquiring recreational facilities for convention hall expansion and football stadium facilities.

It was pointed out by the members from Clark County that this was an emergency measure and immediate action must be taken.

Assemblyman Branch moved "DO PASS" Assemblyman Dini seconded the motion which was unanimously passed.

Chairman Smith appointed Assemblyman Branch to the Public Employees Sub-cimmittee as his name was unintentionly omited from the sub-committee assignments.

Public Employees Sub-Committee Chairman Lauri asked for consideration of the following bills:

AB 16 - Requires public employees and officers to follow constitutional and statutory requirements in matters affecting property rights.

Assemblyman Lauri explained that the bill was similar to AB 78, which has also been referred to this committee. With the consent of the sponsors it was decided to deferr any affirmative action on this bill.

AB 19 - Provides exemption from jury duty for certain firemen.

Assemblyman Dini explained that this bill was primarily for the small counties where the fire departments are volunteer. Assemblyman Ronzone questioned the effect that this would have in larger counties . It was decided to take no action on this bill at this time.
