FEBRUARY 8, 1971

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Smith.

The following bills were taken under advisement by the
Local Government Sub-Committee:

AB 175 - Authorizes certain county fair and recreation boards to
expend "surplus" revenues; removes limitation on boards power;
provides salary for members of certain boards.

AB 184 - Provides that annual audits of funds and accounts
of local governments shall be made under supervision of
Nevada Tax Commission.

AB 187 - Provides additional restrictions on formation and
management of general improvement districts.

AB 192 - Authorizes Secretary of State to accept and spend
grants for the Division of Archives.

AB 205 - Centralizes state law enforcement facilities.

AB 170 - Prohibits further purchase of data processing equipment
or contracts for privately furnished services by state agencies
or political subdivisions.

AB 169 - Creates Nevada Compensation Commission to review
and recommend salaries for public officials.

There was some discussion concerning the terms of office
of the commissioners and the appointing authority, the
sponsors of this bill will draft an amendment to clarify it.

COMMITTEE ACTION:

AB 176 - Increases salaries of Reno mayor and city councilmen.
Assemblyman Lauri moved "DO PASS".
Assemblyman Getto seconded the motion.
The motion carried.

AB 8 - Designates use of former legislative chambers and creates
Capitol Artists Commission.
Assemblyman Frazzini moved to indefinitely postpone the bill.
Assemblyman Bryan seconded the motion.
The motion carried.

AB 49 - Subjects certain water and sewer public utilities to Public Service Control.

AB 61 - Permits boards of county commissioners to assume jurisdiction over water companies.

Assemblyman Ronzone moved to indefinitely postpone the bill.
Assemblyman Branch seconded the motion.
The motion carried.

Assemblyman Branch asked that consideration on AB 139 and AB 142 be postponed until after he has attended a meeting of the City Charter Revision Commission in North Las Vegas next week-end.
