REPORT OF THE SPECIAL SUB-COMMITTEE ON AB 318
APRIL 6, 1971

ALL FOUR SUB-COMMITTEE MEMBERS WERE PRESENT
MR. DENNIS WRIGHT OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL WAS ALSO PRESENT.

THE BILL AS PRINTED AND THE BILL WITH SUGGESTED AMENDMENTS WERE BOTH
CONSIDERED.

SECTION 1 - AMENDED FORM WAS ACCEPTABLE.

SECTION 2 - It was agreed that the committee should be representative
of all of Clark County and not too large so that it would be unable
to work together well.

The committee shall consist of four senators and four representatives
chosen by the Clark County Delegation, representing Las Vegas,
North Las Vegas, Henderson and the unincorporated areas of the County.
The Advisory Board shall consist of one elected representative
from each of the following governing bodies: Henderson, Las Vegas,
North Las Vegas, and the Paradise Valley-Winchester unincorporated
area, plus a representative from Boulder City and a representative
from the Clark County Commission. Each representative on the
Advisory Board will be chosen from their respective governing bodies.
The time and place of the first meeting, which shall take place on or
before June 1, 1971, will be announced by the senior member of the
Committee, who will act as temporary chairman until a chairman
can be elected by the members of the committee.

DELETE SECTION 2 - PARAGRAPH 2 - It was the feeling of the
sub-committee that any compensation would cast a cloud of doubt
on the motives of the committee.

SECTION 3 - 1 - Amend to read "etermine the need, if any, to
realign local governments or other public agencies."

SECTION 3 - 2 - Amend to read "Hold public hearings, seminars and
conferences as necessary to insure that the people of Clark County
are fully informed on any contemplated changes."

SECTION 3 - 3 - AGREEABLE TO ALL IN AMENDED FORM.
It was decided to leave in this part of the bill so that it would
emphasize the desire of the committee to have the traditional
functions of government services operating on the traditional level.

SECTION 3 - 4 - Use language in original bill except change to say
"shall prepare and draft recommended legislation for introduction
to the 1973 Legislative Session and inform all governing bodies con-
cerned."

SECTION 4 - Chairman Smith asked Mr. Wright to draft amendments
which would encourage interlocal and intralocal agreements,
provided that all parties concerned want them.
