

Minutes of Meeting - HEALTH AND WELFARE COMMITTEE - 56th
ASSEMBLY SESSION - March 26, 1971

Meeting convened by Chairman Wilson at 3:10 P.M.

S.B. 93, 94, and 95 - pertaining to cosmetology fees were indefinitely postponed March 23. Dorothy Feeney, Board of Cosmetology, was present to ask the Committee to reconsider these bills.

Mrs. Feeney stated they needed the money in order to operate the Board. The Board is operating on a three man budget when they now have a five man Board. She stated they have a budget of \$40,000 and are only taking in \$29,000. In order to have a good Board we need competent people and to get these people it costs money. If the Board gets the extra money they would like to higher two more inspectors. Some of these shop owners are not meeting certain standards but there are not enough inspectors to check them. Inspectors look for sanitation, wiring, fans, uniforms and such things as that.

Mr. Valentine made a motion to re-consider S.B. 93, 94, and 95; Glaser seconded; motion carried with a vote of 5-1 with Mr. Smalley voting against.

Mr. Valentine made a motion for S.B. 93, 94, and 95 a Do Pass; Homer seconded; motion carried.
