Minutes of Meeting - HEALTH AND WELFARE COMMITTEE - 56th ASSEMBLY SESSION - April 1, 1971

This was a special meeting called to make action on bills that the Committee heard testimony on at an earlier date.

Meeting was convened by Chairman Wilson at 11:30 A.M.

S.B. 326: Establishes state comprehensive planning agency.

Mr. Wilson introduced proposed amendments to the Committee. Homer made a motion to Amend and Do Pass <u>S.B. 326</u>; Smalley seconded; motion carried unanimously.

S.B. 347: Makes certain changes in chiropractic practice administration.

Mr. Smalley made a motion for <u>S.B. 347</u> a Do Pass; Swallow seconded; motion carried unanimously.

<u>S.B. 335</u>: Repeals certain provisions concerning food and drink establishments and removes money limitation for foodhandlers' physical examinations.

Mr. Swallow made a motion for <u>S.B. 335</u> a Do Pass; Smalley seconded; motion carried unanimously.

A.B. 772: Provides for licensing of podiatry hygienists.

Dr. Homer made a motion for \underline{A} , \underline{B} , $\underline{772}$ a Do Pass; Smalley seconded; motion carried unanimously.

<u>S.B. 336</u>: Imposes fee for mental health services and increases qualifications for administrator of such services.

The Committee discussed the fee schedules. Mr. Swallow made a motion for <u>S.B. 336</u> a Do Pass; Smalley seconded; motion carried unanimously.

<u>S.B. 556</u>: Eliminates requirement that State Board of Health meet in Carson City.

Mr. Swallow made a motion for <u>S.B. 556</u> a Do Pass; Homer seconded; motion carried unanimously.

<u>A.B. 501</u>: Provides for licensing of medical laboratory personnel and revises procedure for licensing certain medical laboratories.

Dr. Homer made a motion for <u>A.B. 501</u> a Do Pass; Swallow seconded; motion carried unanimously.
