Minutes of Meeting of April 21, 1971

PRESENT: N. Lauri, Chairman, N. Glaser, R. Young, J Schofield, W. Wilson, R. Torvinen and D. Mello Also Lawrence Jacobsen, Speaker of the Assembly.

The meeting was convened by Chairman, Nick Lauri, in the Assembly Lounge at 3:45 p.m., to discuss and take action on the following:

S.B. 651 - Increases compensation, per diem expense allowances of officers and employees of legislature.

This bill, first considered in the meeting of April 16, 1971, was taken from the Chief Clerk's desk for further consideration and amendments. Motion was made by Roy Young, seconded by Roy Torvinen for a Do Pass on S.B. 651, with the following changes in both the Assembly and Senate:

Section 4, page 2, would be deleted in its entirety and the brackets would remain. Discussion followed. Mr. Mello was not opposed to the salary increase for the Assembly help but objected to the per diem allowances going beyond the sixty day period. The motion for an amend and do pass was carried with Mr. Mello dissenting.

S.B. 654 - Directs Legislative Commission to study Nevada Industrial Commission; provides for payment of costs of study from State Insurance Fund.

Although this study had been previously recommended by the Assembly committee, this bill includes provisions for costs. Motion for a Do Pass on <u>S.B. 654</u> was made by N. Glaser, seconded by J. Schofield and carried.

Mr. Jacobsen suggested that the committee take a little time to study A.B. 829, relating to legislative and other state printing, since it involves some rather radical changes. This will be studied tomorrow at a meeting called for 8:30 a.m., Room 222.
