The meeting was convened at 8:20 a.m.

Mr. Harold Laird discussed the study he had made entitled "Revenue Sharing Proposal, State of Nevada - Local Governments". The concept is based on equal assessment of property through out the State, with more taxes going directly to the State and then being redistributed to the counties, cities and schools on an equitable basis. The State would have more control over local taxing and the counties and cities less control.

The Committee members were concerned as to specific items affected by tax increases; the amount the counties would pay into the state distributive fund and the amount they would get back in return; the counties that would gain and counties that would lose by this system and why.
