

The Taxation Committee gathered at 8:40 a.m., March 18, 1971. The Hearing was called by Chairman T. M. Kean at the request of Paul May.

- (1) Whereas the Committee has previously held hearings concerning AB-361 and AB-725 and have concluded all new material was exhausted and any additional testimony would be repetitious, Mr. Kean granted the request for the sole purpose, as a personal favor to Mr. May, in order to enhance Mr. May's political position with his constituents.
- (2) Whereas the hearing was specifically called for a specific purpose and no other;
- (3) Whereas the sole purpose was to hear Mr. May's constituents, and it was at no time to be considered a meeting, nor was it held on a meeting day.
- (4) Whereas Committee action is not conducted at hearings;

Now, therefore, any ad hoc action attempted by those attending the hearing is ruled not valid.
