

MINUTES OF MEETING - COMMITTEE ON TAXATION - 56TH ASSEMBLY SESSION
April 6, 1971

PRESENT: KEAN, LINGENFELTER, SMALLEY, MAY, GLASER, SMITH

ABSENT: SWALLOW

Chairman Kean convened meeting at 8:45 a.m.

SB-332 Provides that notice of delinquent property taxes shall be given regardless of amount due; corrects terminology in property tax law.

Mr. Smith moved the Committee Do Pass SB-332; Mr. May seconded; motion carried unanimously.

SB-315 Changes method of computing payment of delinquent taxes for conveyance.

Mr. Lingenfelter moved the Committee Do Pass SB-315; Mr May seconded, motion carried unanimously.

SB-476 - Makes technical amendments to law relating to Nevada Tax Commission.

Mr. Knisley said he had talked with Mr. Eein of the Tax Commission and this bill is not adequate. By reason of other legislation, the Tax Commission has no control over Gaming and gasoling taxes.

Mr. Lien will appear before the Committee on Wed, April 7 and discuss this bill

AB-725 Provides new formulas for liquor, cigarette tax distributions to local governments.

Mr. Kean said the amendment to this bill has been prepared and it will be discussed at the next meeting.
