<u>S.C.R. 25</u>:

Mrs. Ford explained the definition regarding abandoned vehicles. She said that the Health Department has kept an eve on this problem but has not been directly involved with it. She also brought up the subject of smashers.

Valentine talked about abandoned vehicles and wrecking yards and salvage.

S.J.R. 30:

Young moved to do pass, Ashworth seconded and it was unanimously passed.

Howard and Kean arrived and Ashworth left.

S.B. 102:

Young moved a do pass, Kean seconded and it was unanimously passed.

S.C.R. 25:

Valentine moved to indefinitely postpone, Howard seconded and all agreed with the exception of Lowman and Young who opposed.

S.B. 638:

Young moved to amend and do pass. Valentine was to get the right number.

Discussion took place regarding the motorcycle bill, A.B. 285.

Valentine moved that Chairman Lowman be authorized to issue a news release along the lines that the Assembly Committee and the Senate Committee have not come to a meeting of the minds and that the Assembly Committee has worked long and hard on this legislation so the responsibility will now be on the Senate Committee if the bill dies.

Davis advised that there were still five bills to be introduced.

One was a cleanup for <u>S.B. 266</u>. There are a very minor amendments to this also. This was to cleanup <u>S.B. 266</u> because it conflicted with three other bills, <u>A.B. 618</u>, <u>629</u> and <u>759</u>, when signed by the Governor. Another will replace <u>A.B.768</u>.

<u>A.B. 768:</u>

Young moved to indefinitely postpone, Valentine seconded and it was unanimously agreed.

A.B. 518:

Amendments are being prepared at the present time.

Discussion took place regarding A.B. 327, the billboard bill.

Chairman Lowman asked if Valentine's amendment on <u>A.B. 327</u>* should be put in as a Committee amendment. Agreed.
