The purpose of the meeting was to discuss further <u>Senate Bills 45</u> and <u>46</u>.

The three main changes to be made are:

- Change the administrative body from the Banking Division to the Insurance Division.
- Whether the percentage for sales commissions should be taken off the front or as each monthly payment is made.
- 3. Whether to use 25% or 15% for the administrative costs.

Chairman Close showed the members a letter he had received from Nevada National Bank regarding their position on the bills.

He advised the committee that he would draft a new bill including the changes mentioned above.

A joint public hearing is scheduled for Thursday, March 18, at 2:30 P.M., in Room 131, on <u>Senate Bill 301</u>.

<u>SB 301</u> -- Creates scheme of automotive insurance permitting recovery without regard to fault.

The Banking Code hearing will be heard Tuesday, March 23, at 2:30 in Room 131.

<u>SB 343</u> -- Revises law governing state banks and banking.
