## SENATE COMMITTEE ON FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS

Minutes of Meeting -- April 17, 1971

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m., with the following committee members present:

AB 131 Relaxes conditions for out-of-county public printing.

Chairman Gibson stated that the proposed amendment had been prepared and was now ready. Senator Dodge moved "Amend and Do Pass", seconded by Senator Monroe. The motion carried.

AB 753 Increases types of services for which county may grant exclusive franchise.

Chairman Gibson said that the Assembly refuses to concur in the Senate amendment to AB 753 with regard to including "ambulance service." They want to go to conference on this, and members of our conference committee will be Senator Gibson, Senator Hecht, and Senator Walker.

SB 467 Authorizes lease of real property interest above or below established grade line of highway pavement.

Chairman Gibson said that it would be necessary to go to conference on this bill as we will not concur with amendments put in by the Assembly Committee on Government Affairs.

SB 293 Modifies procedure for filing plats and broadens definition of "subdivision".

It was explained that the Assembly Committee on Government Affairs had amended this bill with regard to the "three mile" provision, which was done there at the request of the small counties. Senator Swobe moved "we do concur", seconded by Senator Dodge. The motion carried.

Senate Committee on Federal, State, and Local Governments

SB 586 Permits local government budget augmentation if resources available.

Senator Swobe moved "we do concur", seconded by Senator Dodge. The motion carried.

SB 612 Enacts new Reno city charter.

Chairman Gibson explained that there were three amendments put on <u>SB 612</u> by the Assembly Government Affairs Committee. One of the amendments concerning qualification of who may run for the city council is in conflict with what was put in the other city charters. The committee will have to go to conference on this.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
