The fiftieth meeting of the Senate Committee on Federal, State and Local Governments was held on the 20th day of April, 1971.

AB-178 Extends amended provisions of Local Government Employee-Management Relations Act to all government employees; provides for binding arbitration; specifies certain prohibited practices.

Chairman Gibson asked for comments from the committee as to whether or not they should go ahead and try to amend AB-178 to make it more workable and pass it out of committee. Following extensive discussion it was agreed that they would do so.

The committee then went over all the amendments prepared by Mr. Efroymsen, Mr. MacEachern and others, discussing each one and inserting them into the bill where it was felt they would be of benefit to the overall thrust of AB-178.

The meeting was then adjourned until 8:00 A.M. Wednesday, April 21, 1971.
