3. It will require a two-thirds majority of the committee members ~~present~~ to reconsider an action on a bill.
4. The committee members and guests shall address the chair at all times for permission to be heard.
5. There will be no committee action on bills during a hearing.
6. The names of movers and seconds shall be included in the minutes as well as the names of those voting in the minority.

It was agreed by all present to make this committee a very effective one.
