Chairman Schofield convened the meeting by asking for approval of the previous meeting. Approval was given.

AB 356 which would delete requirement that board of trustees of school district approve certain restricted drivers' licenses, was brought up for discussion. Brief discussion followed in which Dr. Broadbent said that this was given him by the Washoe County School Board and he didn't know why it was given him but that he suspected it was a "small potatos matter" that they did not want to be involved.

Assemblyman Lowman made the motion to "do pass" AB 356.

Assemblyman McNeel seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously. Dr. Broadbent to introduce.

AB 357 which would make several changes in procedures relating to suspension and dismissal of education personnel was discussed next.

Assemblyman Vergiels made the motion to indefinitely postpone AB 357.

Assemblyman Foote seconded the motion.
Motion passed with Dr. Broadbent dissenting.

AB 371 which would place the community college division of University of Nevada System on 12-month fiscal operations year, was next on the agenda for discussion.

Assemblyman Lowman suggested that they report this out with no recommendation to Ways and Means. He said that even if they put it on the floor it would go to Ways and Means.

Margie Foote moved that they delay action on this until they knew more what it did.
Motion seconded.

Brief discussion followed in which it was agreed to ask Mr. Hayes to speak on behalf of his bill. Motion carried unanimously.



AB 407 which would create a crime of selling certain academic writing was next for discussion.

Mr. McNeel moved to do pass AB 407. Mr. Barengo seconded the motion.

Discussion followed. Richard Morgan asked if this bill didn't have a legal connotation.

Motion passed unanimously. McNeel to introduce.

AB 411 which would amend provisions for reemployment of public school teachers, was discussed. Chairman asked Dr. Hansen what he thought about this bill and he answered that he saw no problems with it.

Mr. Vergiels made the motion to do pass AB 411.

Mr. Barento seconded.

Motion passed unanimously. Assemblyman Barengo to introduce.
