### 5. AB 302

Chairman Foote read the bill for the benefit of Committee and guests.

Mr. Flander: The bill was necessitated by the inadvertent repeal of the last Legislature of the voters assistance act. I have actually drafted this bill to make it a simple process for the disabled so that less obstructions

appear and recommend it to the Committee.

Mr. Winters: I feel this bill is something I could live with. My memorandum was somewhat more specific. This bill provides for an assistant and sets up the qualifications for a disabled person to get an assistant but it doesn't set up the procedures. However, if you don't want to do it, that is alright with me.

Assemblyman Ford: It appears to me if there became a problem in any of the details that are not in here, it would appear the Secretary of State or Registrar of Voters would have the power to carry those details out. I have spoken wit several people plus Mr. Colton and they feel additional detailed language is not that necessary or desirable. I move "Do Pass."
